SUBJECT: Authorize the Department of Environmental Health to Apply for and Accept LEA Grant Funds

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

1. Authorize the Department of Environmental Health to apply for and accept State grant funds designated to assist in the support of the solid waste facilities permit and inspection programs.
2. Adopt Resolution No. 2009-186

BACKGROUND:

The Riverside County Department of Environmental Health (Department) has been designated the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB). The LEA is responsible for the permitting, inspection and enforcement of certain waste facilities within its jurisdiction. The CIWMB will disburse grant funds statewide to supplement the LEA's existing budget for equipment, supplies, training, personnel and technical support. The approval of Resolution 2009-186 will authorize the Department to accept these grant funds.

3 **A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF**
4 **ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT**
5 **LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY GRANT FUNDS**

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7 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the California Integrated
8 Waste Management Board (CIWMB) to administer various Grant Programs in furtherance of the
9 State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State,
10 thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

12 WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority the CIWMB is required to establish procedures
13 governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

14 WHEREAS, Grant Application procedures require an Applicant's governing body to authorize by
15 resolution its approval for submittal of the Grant Application(s) identified below, and the designation by
16 job title of the individual authorized to execute all Grant documents on behalf of Riverside County
17 Department of Environmental Health; and


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19 WHEREAS, if awarded, Riverside County Department of Environmental Health will enter into a
20 Grant Agreement with the CIWMB for implementation of said Grant(s).

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors
22 authorizes the submittal of application(s) to the CIWMB for all grants for which Riverside County
23 Department of Environmental Health is eligible.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective for July 1, 2009 through June
25 30, 2014; time period not to exceed five (5) years from date of adoption;
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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Environmental Health or
2 his/her designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the Riverside County
3 Department of Environmental Health all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications,
4 agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the
5 approved grant project.
