3. Amend the 2008-2009 One-Year Action Plan of the 2004-2009 Five-Year Consolidated Plan by adding the following CDBG-R funded projects:

**BACKGROUND:** On May 4, 2009, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) issued the *Notice of Program Requirements* for the Community Development Block Grant-Recovery (CDBG-R) Program funds under Title XII of the *American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009* (ARRA). The County's allocation is \$2,797,049. The primary purpose of the CDBG-R is to stimulate the economy through measures that modernize the Nation's infrastructure, improve energy efficiency, and expand educational opportunities and access to health care. In order to receive these CDBG-R funds, the County must prepare and submit a Substantial Amendment to the County's 2008-2009 One Year Action Plan of the 2004-2009 Five Year Consolidated Plan.

The Agency has indentified three (3) projects that comply with the eligible activities and national objectives as set forth in the CDBG regulations [24 CFR Part 570] as well as the requirements of Title XII of the *American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009* (ARRA) – including projects or activities that can be started and completed expeditiously.

On May 26, 2009, the Agency published a public notice informing the public of the seven-day substantial amendment comment period and invited concerned citizens to review the proposed CDBG-R Substantial Amendment on-line. The Substantial Amendment was also made available for review at the Agency's Spruce Street office. A summary of all public comments received have been incorporated into the Substantial Amendment.

The Agency recommends approval of the CDBG-R Substantial Amendment to the 2008-2009 One-Year Action Plan and authorization to submit the final CDBG-R Substantial Amendment to HUD no later than June 5, 2009.

**FINANCIAL:** The Community Development Block Grant-Recovery (CDBG-R) Program is federally-funded grant to be received through HUD under Title XII of the *American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009* (ARRA).
