

BACKGROUND:

The Friends of the Desert Mountains (Friends) has created the Lake Cahuilla Shoreline Management Plan along with the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians. The Plan will inventory lands associated with the shoreline of ancient Lake Cahuilla in the southeastern portion of the Coachella Valley to identify areas of High, Medium, and Low priorities for acquisition to preserve cultural resources. It will also identify management needs and develop a programmatic management plan for these resource areas.

We would like to use Fourth District Community Improvement Designation funds to assist the Friends in ensuring that resources are adequately protected and interpreted in the years to come.
