**SUBJECT:** One Year Extension of Contract with United Way of the Inland Valleys

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Extend the contract for one year with the United Way of the Inland Valleys as the Principal Combined Fund Drive Organization for Riverside County, through FY 2009/10.

**BACKGROUND:** Each year in the fall, employees are given the opportunity to contribute to charities by payroll deductions. Board Policy C-14 provides for a single organization to head up the fund drive as the "Principal Fund Drive Organization" (PCFO) for a five year period.

A contract was awarded on June 14, 2004, Agenda item 3.21, to the United Way of the Inland Valleys to provide services as the Principal Fund Drive Organization. Human Resources and the current campaign chairperson recommend extending the contract with United Way for one year in order to support the continuation of services that are currently provided for this year's fundraising and offer a seamless transition into the RFP process when fund raising season has ended.
