**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of an eight feet wide decomposed granite (DG) regional trail on Palomar Street and Bryant Street, City of Wildomar. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, July 15, 2009 at which time bids will be opened.

**BACKGROUND:** The proposed trail is located on Palomar Street from Morelock Way to Mission Trail and on Bryant Street from Grand Avenue to Palomar Street, and it includes the construction of a an eight feet wide decomposed granite regional trail, a Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) fence and associated improvements.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel and the City of Wildomar.

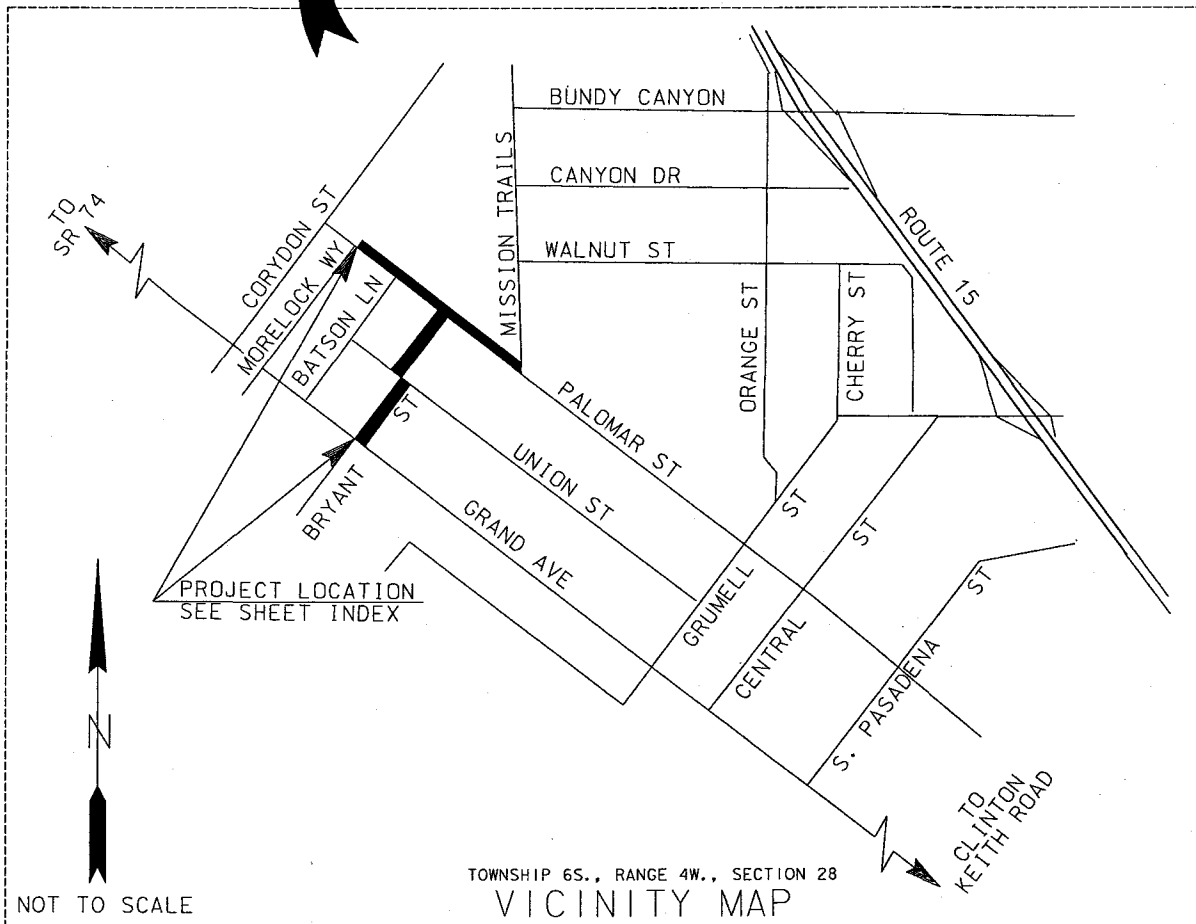
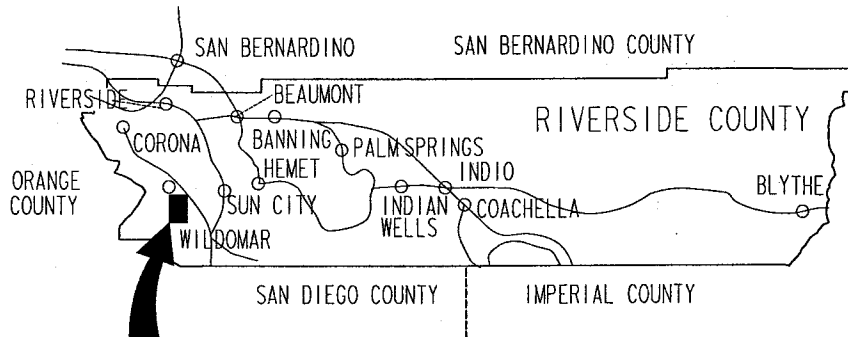
