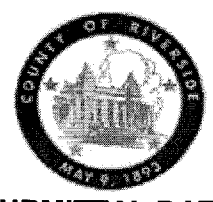

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department needs engineering support services to deliver all the necessary road improvement projects identified and funded in the Transportation Improvement Program. The Board of Supervisors approved and executed an agreement between the County and PBS&J on December 19, 2006 to provide the Transportation Department with the needed services. to extend the term of the contract for the first of the two optional one-year extensions.

PBS&J is currently assisting the Transportation Department with the technical and administrative services needed to process and implement several active EDA funded projects. Some of these projects include Garfield Avenue sidewalk, Highgrove; Bermuda Dunes; Mission Blvd, Bellegrave Avenue & Ben Nevis Blvd, Glen Avon; 42nd Avenue/Yucca Lane retention basin, Bermuda Dunes; Mesa Verde community paving, Mesa Verde; Wilkinson Street paving, Meadowbrook; Camino Real raised median, Rubidoux; Van Buren Blvd widening, Rubidoux; and Market Street widening & signals, Belltown. The Transportation Department desires the continued services of PBS&J to complete these projects.

All associated contract costs will be funded using project funds. Thus, no net county costs will be incurred as a result of this contract amendment.

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AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT
for On-Call Engineering Services
between County of Riverside – Transportation Department
and PBS&J

THIS AMENDMENT (hereinafter the "Amendment") to an agreement is made and entered into as of this _____ day of _____, 2009, by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter the "COUNTY"), and PBS&J (hereinafter "ENGINEER").

RECITALS

- A. COUNTY and ENGINEER have entered in an agreement entitled "On-Call Engineering Services between County of Riverside – Transportation Department and PBS&J" that is dated December 19, 2006 (hereinafter the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides the terms and conditions, scope of work, schedule and budget for the performance of professional and technical services necessary to provide on-call engineering services.
- B. Appendix B • Article BI establishes the time period for allowing work assignments to be authorized under the original agreement. The terms and conditions specify that work assignment can be authorized until June 30, 2009 and that the authority to execute work assignments can be modified through one-year supplemental extensions. The agreement allows for two separate one-year extensions. The ENGINEER is satisfactorily performing the duties under this agreement and the Transportation Department continues to need the services provided. The parties therefore now desire to implement the first one-year extension of the authority to execute work assignments.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The authority to authorize work assignments under this contract is hereby extended from June 30, 2009 to June 30, 2010 in accordance with Appendix B • Article BI of the original agreement.
- 2. Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all of the terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.


IN WITNESS HEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Amendment to the Agreement to be duly executed and signed by their duly authorized representatives on this day and year first written above.
