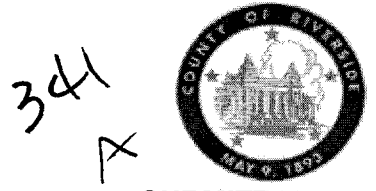

Street and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. The improvements are intended to benefit the community of Mecca by eliminating blight and by providing much needed road improvements for pedestrian access and improved street drainage. The improvements will include the reconstruction of the existing pavement and the addition of sidewalk and curb and gutter. The installation of replacement street lighting along these streets will be included as an alternate bid item on the bid schedule and may be done as part of Phase I if any utility conflicts can be resolved, and if not may be done with a future phase.

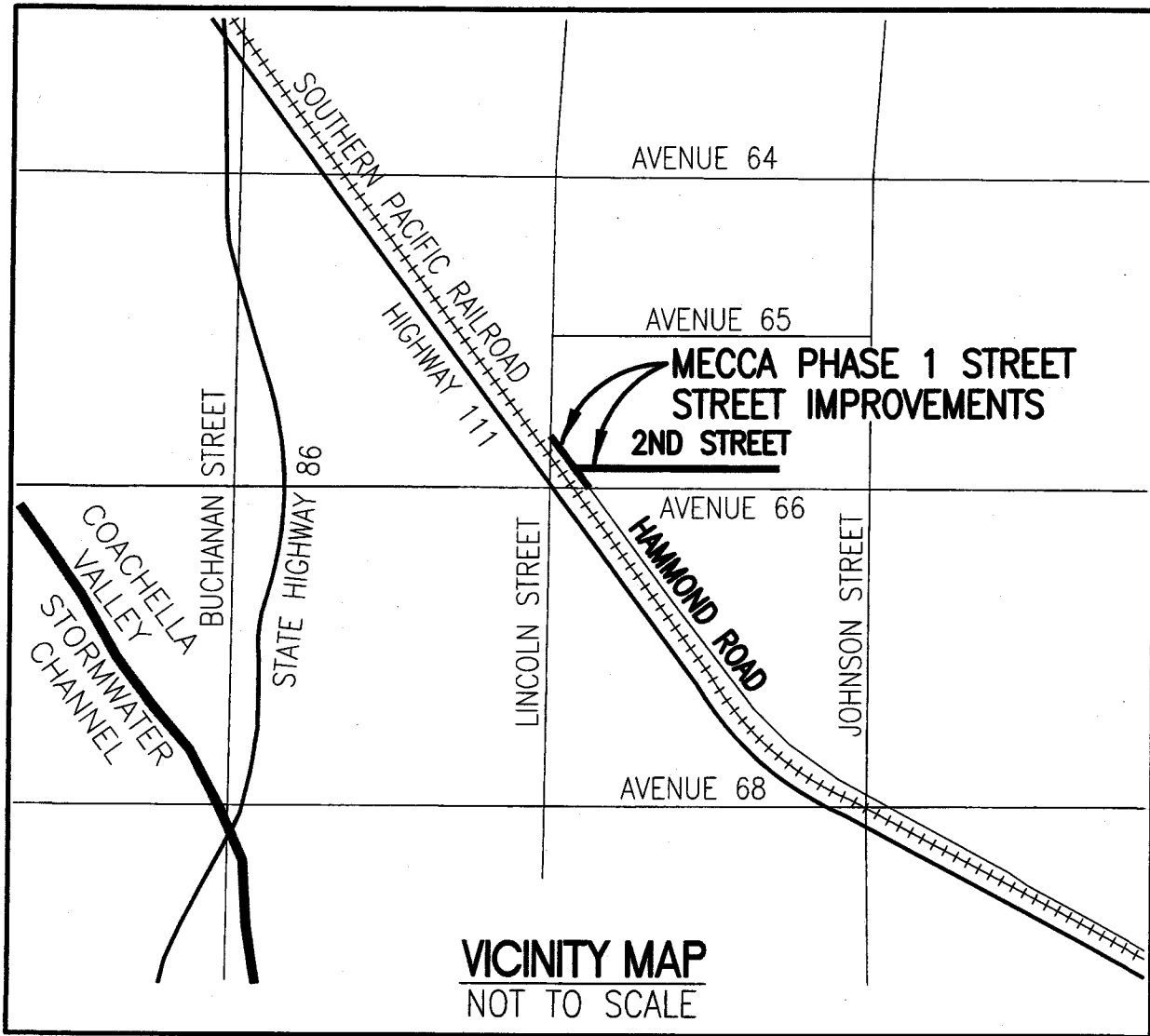
This project is the first phase of a comprehensive revitalization and upgrade of streets and sidewalks in the Mecca area. Additional phases of construction, subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors, are planned to include street improvements on other streets within the downtown Mecca area. These streets include: 66<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Street, 6<sup>th</sup> Street, 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln Street, Coahuilla Street, Date Palm Street, Brown Street, Dale Kiler Road, Home Avenue and Frank J Valdovino Road.

The proposed work on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and Hammond Road will be funded by the Redevelopment Agency through a cooperative agreement that will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for execution prior to, or concurrent with, the award of the construction contract.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.
