
SUBJECT: Probation, Parole and Community Supervision Week

BACKGROUND: The week of July 19, 2009 through July 25, 2009, has been declared Probation, Parole and Community Supervision week. This event is sponsored by the American Probation and Parole Association, a national organization consisting of professional correctional professionals dealing with community supervision issues.

It is befitting to recognize the efforts of our sworn professionals with the Probation Department who provide important services such as monitoring compliance with court orders, assisting offenders in obtaining housing and employment, overseeing the rehabilitation of offenders, conducting work and home visits of offenders, administering drug tests and providing services, support and protection for victims of crime. To accomplish this, sworn professionals must become competent in addressing issues for drug and alcohol abuse, sexual deviancy, child abuse, domestic violence and mental illness.

PROBATION, PAROLE AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK

July 19 – 25, 2009

Whereas the Riverside County Probation Department is an essential and integral part of the criminal justice system; and,

Whereas the Probation Department sworn professionals upholds the law with impartiality and integrity and works diligently toward the rehabilitation of probationers, while at the same time recognizing the right of the public to be safe-guarded from criminal activity; and,

Whereas the Probation Department sworn professionals are responsible for providing the Court with information for offender sentencing, enforcing Court orders through supervision of adult and juvenile offenders in our communities, and housing and treatment of juvenile offenders; and,

Whereas Probation Officers and Probation Corrections Officers promotes crime prevention, intervention and victim advocacy, and restorative justice; and,

Whereas Probation Officers and Probation Corrections Officers can help offenders gain skills, get treatment and community support that will enable them to live successful crime free lives. These officers can also recognize when an offender may not be ready or able to make the changes necessary to ensure public safety; and,

Whereas Probation Officers and Probation Corrections Officers are trained professionals who change lives through services and referrals for criminal offenders, their families and victims of crime; and,

Whereas Probation Officers and Probation Corrections Officers protect victims and provide them with necessary services; and,

Whereas Probation Officers and Probation Corrections Officers work in partnership with other community agencies and public service organizations in such valuable programs as the Violence Against Women Program, Gang Task Force and the Sexual Offenders Task Force, Youthful Offender Program; and,

Whereas the American Probation and Parole Association, has declared July 19 through July 25, 2009, as National American Probation, Parole, and Community Supervision Week; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, in regular session, July 14, 2009 hereby proclaims the week of July 19 through July 25-2009 to be National American Probation, Parole and Community Supervision Week.
