SUBJECT: Approval of 2009 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) Award and Resolution No. 2009-245

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

1. Approve the 2009 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant application;
2. Adopt Resolution No. 2009-245, authorizing the Sheriff to sign the grant agreement and any future amendments, modifications, and/or claims;
3. Approve and direct the Auditor Controller to make the budget adjustments on the attached Schedule A; and
4. Authorize the Sheriff to sign an agreement with the City of Indio for their portion of the grant.

BACKGROUND: The State Corrections Standards Authority (CSA) has allocated funding to the County under the Federal Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) 2009 Program. The purpose of this funding is to promote development or continuation of local juvenile justice programs that hold juvenile offenders accountable to the community and courts. The allocation to Riverside County for expenditures during Fiscal Year 2009-2010 is \$81,656, with a 10% match (\$9,073) of total project costs of \$90,729.

In Fiscal Year 2009-2010 JABG funding of \$46,103 will be used to support the collection of data for the Coachella Valley Violent Gang Task Force (CVVGTF) by reimbursing the salary and benefits of an Office Assistant III position from the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

The balance of the JABG funding, \$35,553, will be made available for reimbursement to the City of Indio for expenditures on behalf of the Gang Task Force for services and supplies. The City of Indio will fund their share of the match. The Sheriff's Department will prepare a funding agreement between the city and county.

The allocation of project funding to the two agencies will be:
