**SUBJECT:** Acceptance of California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) Project Safe Neighborhood Grant and Adoption of Resolution 2009-193

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve acceptance of a California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) Project Safe Neighborhood Grant award in the amount of \$5,000 for the grant period October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009.
2. Adopt Resolution 2009-193 authorizing the District Attorney to submit a Project Safe Neighborhood grant application to the California Emergency Management Agency and sign grant agreement on behalf of the Board through FY 2009-2010.
3. Approve and direct the Auditor Controller to make budget adjustments as shown in Attachment A.

**BACKGROUND:** The California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA), Law Enforcement and Victim Services Division, on behalf of the U.S. Attorney's Office Central District of California has awarded one time funds to support the PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS/ANTI-GANG INITIATIVE (PSN/AGI) Program. The PSN/AGI Program is dedicated to supporting new and expanded anti-gun and anti-gang prevention and enforcement efforts. The Project Safe Neighborhood's Anti-Gang Initiative Program will help the Riverside District Attorney's Office obtain gang injunctions against some of the most violent criminal street gangs in the Coachella Valley. The Riverside District Attorney's Office will utilize the requested funds to develop computer programs to assist in the organization and presentation of information relating to the activities of criminal street gangs and their members. The software will also aid prosecutors in the preparation of the numerous lengthy legal documents that are filed in conjunction with a request for a civil gang injunction. The grant period is from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009 but these one time funds will be expended during the 2009-2010 FY.
