BACKGROUND: The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements. The proposed traffic signal meets traffic signal warrants and will improve safety by providing protected traffic movements and pedestrian crossings.

RE: Construction of Traffic Signal and Lighting, at Limonite Avenue and Lucretia Avenue, Mira Loma area.

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This project will also provide striping and signing improvements at the intersection and pavement widening on Limonite Avenue. The pavement widening on Limonite Avenue will be striped to add an additional eastbound lane and therefore increase traffic capacity.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

The relocations and adjustments of utilities, owned by the Jurupa Community Services District, are included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If the District approves the award of the alternate bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the costs for the work will be funded by the District.

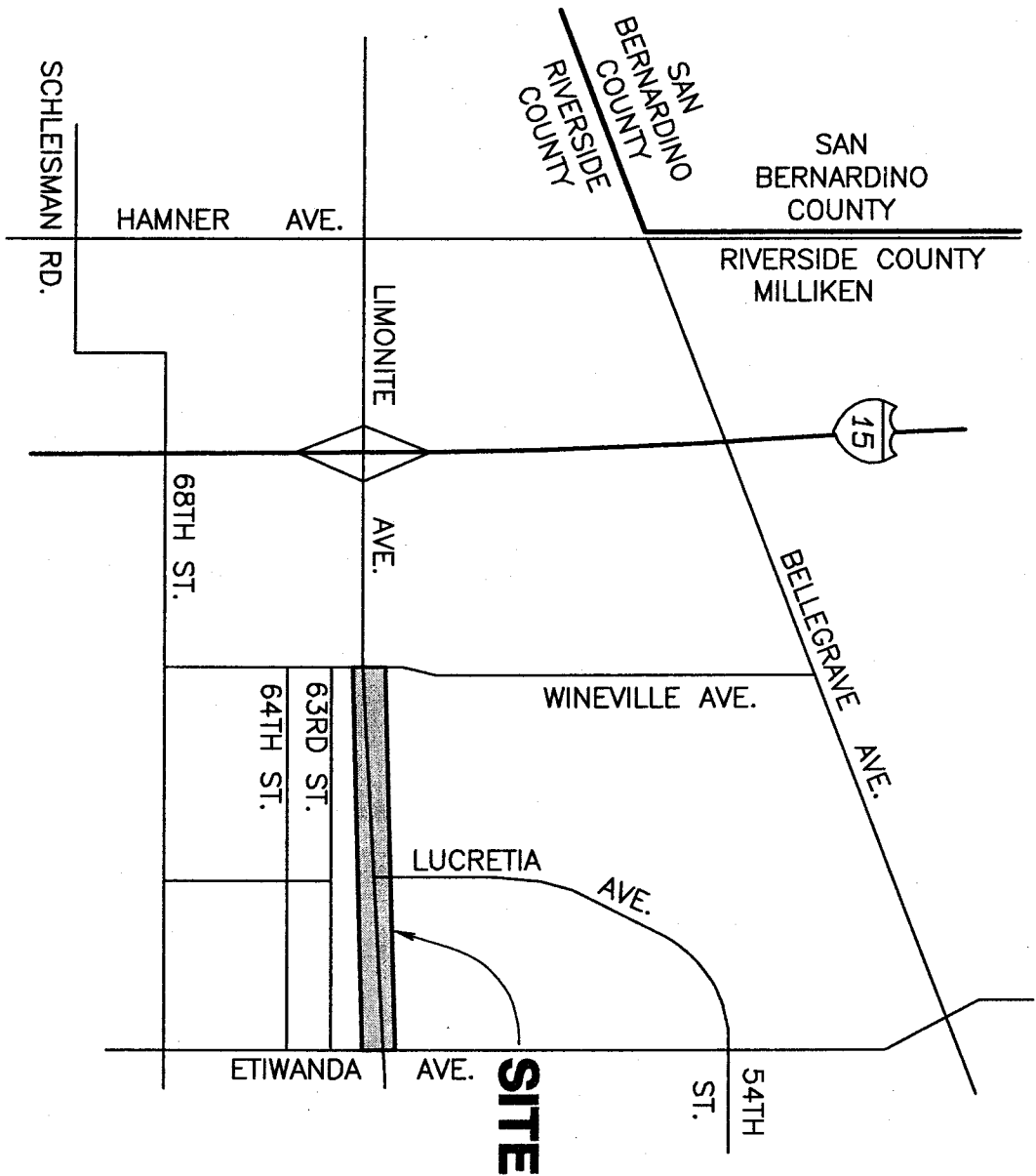
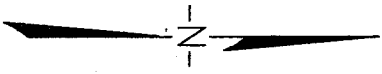
The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.
