SUBJECT: Chiriaco Summit Airport - Apron Rehabilitation Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Bid Documents for the Apron Rehabilitation Project;
2. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids for Construction of Airport Improvements; and
3. Delegate Change Order authority to the Assistant County Executive Officer/EDA or designee in accordance with Board Policy B-11.

BACKGROUND: The purpose of the project is the rehabilitation of the Apron Taxiway area adjacent to runway 6-24 located at the Chiriaco Summit Airport. The project is consistent with the airport's development plan. Specific improvements will include apron re-construction, segmented circle placement and airfield markings in keeping with current State Division of Aeronautics guidelines for General Aviation facilities. The California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS), Division of Aeronautics, will review and approve the contract documents. The project will be funded with CALTRANS Division of Aeronautics grants, and Aviation Division Capital Improvement Funds. There will be no impact upon the County's General Fund.

The California Department of Transportation (Department), Division of Aeronautics, has reviewed the plans and specifications for Projects CAAP # Riv-4-07-1 for Segmented Circle and CAAP # Riv-4-08-1 for Slurry Taxiway, rebuild ramp and repaint at the Chiriaco Summit Airport. Please ensure comments are included for plans and specifications as below.

Plans

1. Quantities for asphalt concrete, prime coat, slurry seal and pavement marking in proper units
2. Type of asphalt concrete and slurry seal.

Specifications

1. Minimum 7 days waiting period before applying paint for pavement marking
2. Bid date

One copy of the approved plans and specifications is being returned for your records. This letter is a confirmation of the prior authorization given to the County of Riverside (County) to solicit construction bids for both projects and to confirm the Department's prior maximum allocation of \$18,000 and \$117,000 to the County for these projects.

When bids are received, please submit an abstract of the bids, together with the County's designation of the successful bidder for Departmental approval. After approval, the Department will initiate a Grant Agreement setting forth the terms under which State funds will be disbursed, and will authorize the award of the State's portion of the construction project. If, for any reason, the State does not approve the designated bidder, or if the designated bidder refuses to enter into the contract, the County may recommend that the award be given to the next lowest bidder, or that the project be rebid.

The above approval of specifications should not be construed as assurance that State funds will be available for items not related to the Segmented Circle and the Slurry Taxiway, rebuild ramp and repaint Projects.
