3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute said Agreement on behalf of the County.

**BACKGROUND:**

On July 1, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved a Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and the City of Palm Desert for the development of the Cove Communities Sheriff Station in Palm Desert. The 85,000 square foot state-of-the-art facility will be located on 10.87 acres on Gerald Ford Drive near Monterey Avenue in the City of Palm Desert. Pursuant to the agreement, the County of Riverside is required to participate in the Palm Desert Art in Public Places Program, which is intended to create an artistic harmony between the City's buildings, landscaping, and open spaces.

The commissioned artwork for the Cove Communities Sheriff Station will entail two different works of art. The first piece of artwork depicts three life-size bronze figures in a conversational setting. The sculpture portrays the Riverside County Sheriff's Department's desire to protect and serve the community through compassion and teamwork. The second piece of artwork is a monument that will display two 2'x2' Riverside County Sheriff badges cast in bronze. The artwork design has been approved in concept by the Sheriff's Department.

Jewett Sculptures submitted a formal proposal which details the scope of work for the sculpture and monument with bronze badges. The proposal encompasses complete design of the artwork, fabrication, and/or procurement and installation of all components described or depicted in the proposal.

The City of Palm Desert's Art in Public Places Committee presented the County of Riverside's artwork proposal to the City Council, who unanimously approved the artwork in concept during their July 9, 2009 meeting.

EDA recommends that a purchase order be issued by County Purchasing. The costs of the artwork are within the Cove Communities Sheriff Station construction budget approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 25, 2008, and no additional net county costs will be incurred as a result of this agreement.

**FINANCIAL DATA:**

All costs associated with this project are fully funded through the Riverside County Palm Desert Financing Authority bond proceeds FY 09/10. Thus no additional net county costs will be incurred as a result of this agreement.



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4. **Date of Delivery:** the Artist agrees to complete the work within 11months of the signing of the agreement. The completion date shall be extended for such period of time as the Artist may be disabled by illness preventing progress of work. The completion date shall also be extended in the event of delays caused by events beyond the control of the Artist, including but not limited to fire, theft, strikes, shortages of materials, and acts of God.

5. **Termination:** The Buyer shall have the right to terminate this agreement if for any reason the art work is delayed for more than six months from the completion date or if the events beyond the Artist control cause a delay of more than six months in the completion date. This agreement represents the entire agreement of the parties hereto as to the matters contained herein and supersedes any and all prior written or verbal agreements between the parties.

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THIS AGREEMENT WILL BE NULL AND VOID IF NOT EXECUTED BY BUYER and approved by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside.

## Proposal for Cove Communities Sheriff Station

August 6, 2009

### DISCRIPTION

3 life-size bronze figures. One (1) male deputy sheriff 6'3 one (1) female deputy sheriff kneeling and one (1) boy standing 4'8". Bronze sculpture will sit on a 7' x 6' square concrete base 3' high. The sculpture base will be faced with rock which fits into the overall architectural design of the building and landscape. The customer shall provide all lighting for the monument.

**Maintenance-** Bronze sculptures exhibited outdoors need to be waxed once a year to avoid oxidation.

### DISCRIPTION

Two (2) bronze Riverside County Sheriff's badges cast in bronze, one on each side of the concrete monument. The monument will be 5' x 5' x 1' faced with rock which fits into the architectural scheme of the building and landscape. Each badge will be 3' x 3' in the image of the Riverside County Sheriff badge. The customer shall provide all lighting for the monument.

**Maintenance-** The bronze badges would require yearly maintenance of waxing and polishing.

### Total

Total cost for all 5 bronze sculptures (includes delivery & installation) **\$135,000.00**

**This quote does not include the sculpture base or monument base.**

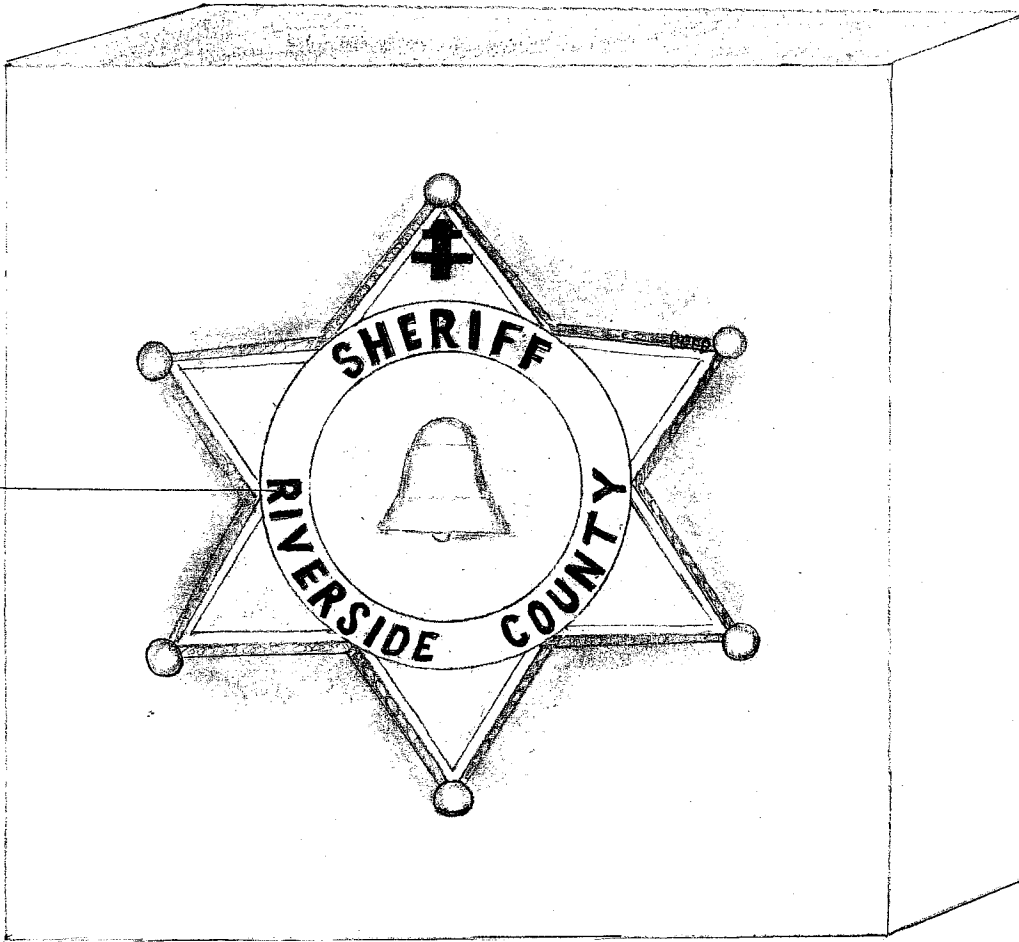
