area. Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District is providing the County of Riverside an easement to facilitate installation of a pedestrian bridge adjacent to the existing bridge. The Board authorized the award for construction of the pedestrian bridge by Minute Order Dated June 30, 2009 (Agenda Item 3.71). The License Agreement would give the County the ability to construct, operate, and maintain a new pedestrian bridge along Mayberry Avenue, crossing the Bautista Creek Channel. The pedestrian bridge will not conflict with the channel's primary function or with the District's continuing operation and maintenance of the channel.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form and the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District has this item on a concurrent agenda.
