SUBJECT: Waiver of Hidden Valley Wildlife Area Park Fee for the City of Riverside

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Regional Park and Open-Space District to waive the day-use fee for entrance to the Hidden Valley Wildlife Area.

BACKGROUND: The honorable Mayor Loveridge, City of Riverside, has introduced a monthly program *Walk with the Mayor*, which promotes fitness and use of various trails in and around the City of Riverside.

The program has been met with great interest and participation by local citizens this summer and there have been three walks thus far. Mayor Loveridge is asking permission to take the next walk through the Hidden Valley Wildlife Area and requests the waiver of parking and the use fee normally assessed. If approved, the walk will be held September 19, 2009 from 7:30a.m. to 8:45 a.m., with walkers arriving at the park site at 7:15 a.m. The Regional Park and Open-Space District supports this activity as it is within its mission to promote healthy life styles in Riverside County. It also gives the public and opportunity to familiarize themselves with the local trails in the area.
