BACKGROUND:

The Riverside County Peace Officer Memorial Foundation is a non-profit organization that honors Riverside County's peace officers who have died in the line of duty serving the County, State and Federal law enforcement agencies. It also provides maintenance and upkeep for current and future memorial sites.

Shelter from the Storm provides emergency shelter, counseling, advocacy, and supportive services to women and their children who are victims of domestic violence. The loss of State funding is especially significant to this organization. Immediate attention is needed to ensure that essential services will be provided.

We would like to use Fourth District Community Improvement funds to assist these two organizations.
