SUBJECT: FY09 US Department of Homeland Security Grant Program Acceptance of Award and Approved Projects

RECOMMENDED MOTION: that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt resolution 2009-297 accepting the FY09 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) award and projects;
2. Accept the FY09 HSGP award in the amount of \$4,555,177 on behalf of the Riverside County Operational Area (OA) and;
3. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to make budget adjustments as outlined in the Schedule A

BACKGROUND: On June 9, 2009 the County Board of Supervisors passed Agenda 3.21 allowing application and designating Authorized Agents for the FY09 HSGP. The California Emergency Management Agency has awarded the Riverside County OA federal pass-through funding in the amount of \$4,555,177 to enhance local agencies and jurisdictions abilities to prevent, deter, respond to and recover from threats and incidents of terrorism and catastrophic events. The HSGP grant award includes both State Homeland Security Funding (SHSGP) and Metropolitan Medical Response Systems (MMRS) funding. The MMRS funds are available only to the county's Department of Public Health. The lead agency for the HSGP grant, on behalf of the OA, is Riverside County Fire – OES.

BACKGROUND (continued)

The County Board of Supervisors appointed the Anti Terrorism Approval Authority (ATAA) on December 18, 2002 (3.26) to review all funding requests in order to determine the utilization of the HSGP funding. In the FY09 application process 3 County Agencies, 3 Special Districts, 2 Tribes and 16 cities submitted applications to ATAA as individual agencies or as part of an agency. The final application recommended by ATAA and submitted to the State included 15 projects among 29 Cities/Agencies. The funding distribution is as follows:
