SUBJECT: Construction of raised median improvements on Camino Real from Mission Boulevard to Avenida Baja/River Glen Drive, in the Rubidoux area.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of raised median improvements on Camino Real from Mission Boulevard to Avenida Baja/River Glen Drive, in the Rubidoux area. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, December 16, 2009, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: In 2005, Patriot High School was constructed at the southwest corner of Camino Real and Mission Boulevard. After observing the traffic conditions in front of the new school, the Transportation Department determined that a raised median would be beneficial to prevent U-turns and to channelize traffic flow generated by the school. Therefore in 2006, the

Transportation Department installed an interim median consisting of asphalt concrete berms along Camino Real from Mission Boulevard to Avenida Baja/River Glen Drive. The median was successful at improving operating conditions for pedestrians and motorists using Camino Real, especially during peak hours before and after school.

The proposed project intends to replace the interim asphalt concrete berms with concrete curbs, and to install decorative concrete pavers and cobblestones within the median.

As part of a separate contract to construct the Jurupa Valley Aquatic Center, the Redevelopment Agency for Riverside County will add irrigation and planting to the median. The median hardscape and landscape will be maintained by the Riverside County Parks and Open Space District, which will be operating and maintaining the Jurupa Valley Aquatic Center.

The proposed work to construct a concrete raised median on Camino Real will be funded by the Redevelopment Agency (RDA) through a cooperative agreement with the County that will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for execution prior to, or concurrent with, the award of the construction contract. Preparation of the plans and specifications was funded by RDA under a prior agreement.

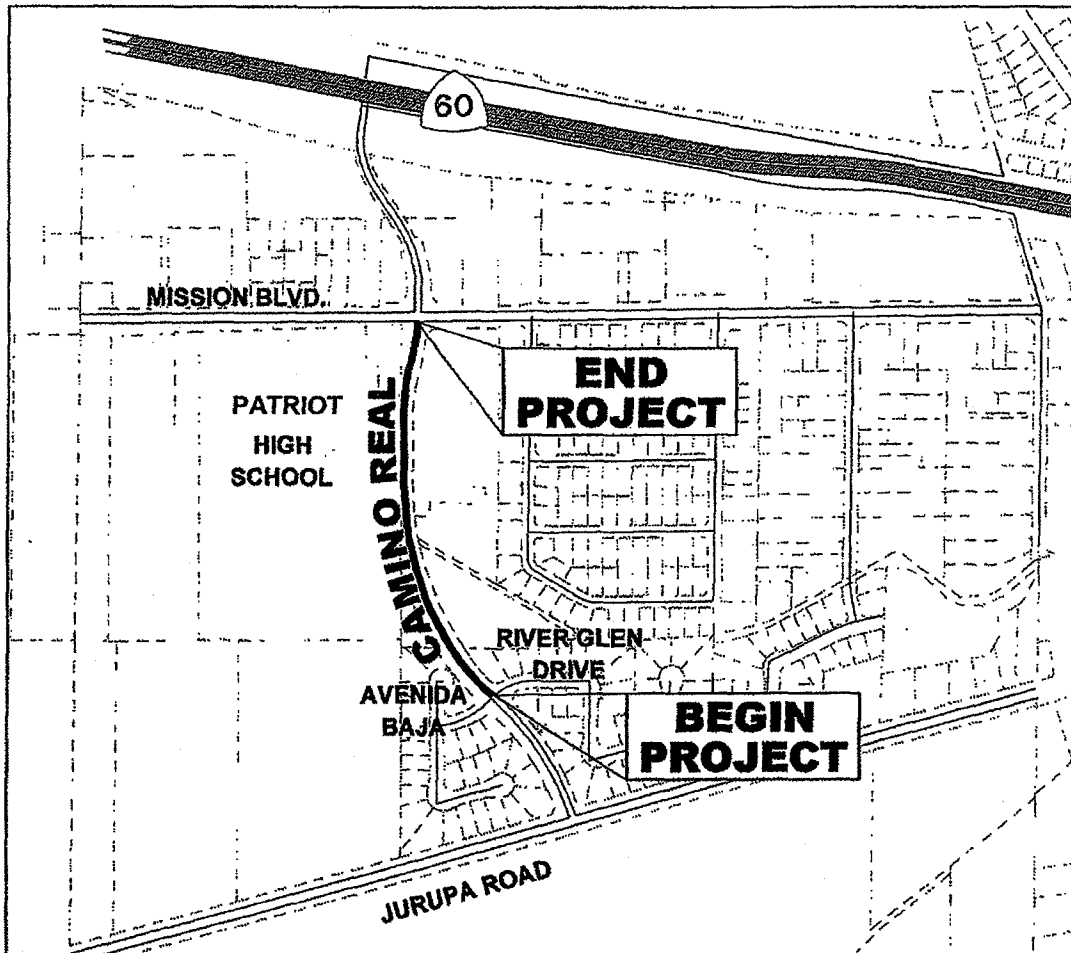
The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
