SUBJECT: Report on ACORN related transactions with the County of Riverside

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors receive and file this report on ACORN related transactions with the County of Riverside.

BACKGROUND: During the opening comments of the September 29, 2009 Board of Supervisors meeting, Supervisor Stone expressed concern regarding alleged voter registration fraud perpetrated by The Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now (ACORN). Consequently, Supervisor Stone directed the Registrar of Voters to perform a cursory review of voter registrations submitted by ACORN and report back in 60 days. Supervisor Stone also directed the Executive Office to report on any payments made to ACORN on behalf of the county.

The Registrar of Voters reports it has not issued any voter registration cards to ACORN. It should be noted that the Registrar of Voters would be unable to identify any registrations cards that may have been picked up by an ACORN representative unless the person identified himself/herself as such. The Executive Office reviewed financial records from July 2002 through October 2009 and found that no payments have been made to the ACORN organization.
