**BACKGROUND:**

The Riverside County Regional Medical Center Foundation's 2009 Festival of Trees event will include a holiday extravaganza at the Riverside Convention Center from November 24<sup>th</sup> through November 29<sup>th</sup> and a fundraising gala to be held on November 24<sup>th</sup>.
