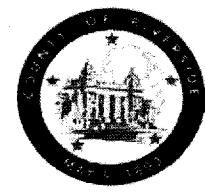

SUBJECT: Approval of the First Amendment to Professional Service Agreements with Sole Source Providers for the Sheriff's Violence Against Women Grant Project.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve and authorize the Chairperson and Sheriff- Coroner -PA to execute the First Amendment to the Agreements on behalf of the County with Alternatives to Domestic Violence, Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center, Safe Alternatives for Everyone and Shelter From the Storm.

BACKGROUND: On November 4, 2008 (3.38), the Board approved a grant award from the Office on Violence Against Women as a supplement to the original award to continue vital service to victims of domestic violence for another two year period. A portion of the grant continues funding for six advocate positions from four advocacy groups that provide the necessary supportive services to victims of domestic violence and training to our Deputy Sheriffs.

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BACKGROUND: (continued)

On March 31, 2009, (3.38) the Board approved Professional Service Agreements with Alternatives to Domestic Violence, Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center, Safe Alternatives for Everyone and Shelter From the Storm to continue the necessary supportive services. This amendment has no financial impact.

The Sheriff's Department wants to amend the Agreements to allow the Contractors to submit their invoices for payment on a monthly basis versus a quarterly basis. The amendments have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN
COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND SHELTER FROM THE STORM.**

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Professional Services between the County of Riverside on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department and Shelter from the Storm, approved by the Board of Supervisors on March 31, 2009, for services effective July 1, 2008 through August 31, 2010 is hereby amended in the following respects only:

**IV. Section D. METHOD, TIME, AND SCHEDULE/ CONDITION OF PAYMENTS:
is amended to read as follows:**

METHOD, TIME, AND SCHEDULE/CONDITION OF PAYMENTS

1. The Contractor will be paid the actual amount of each monthly claim for payment.
 - a. To accurately project and report expenditures to the grantor, the Contractor will submit monthly invoices and backup that is accompanied by a detailed expense report, payroll report, and actual receipts for expenses such as health, dental, and workers compensation insurance.
 - b. Monthly invoices and their supporting documentation are due by the 10th day of the following month.
2. All claims submitted in a timely and complete manner shall be processed within twenty (20) working days of receipt by RCSD and forwarded to the Auditor-Controller's office for payment. If the required supporting documentation or actual receipts are not provided, RCSD will delay payment until the report or receipts are received by RCSD.
