2. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to place an advertisement for the Public Hearing in the appropriate local publications; and
3. Upon the close of the Public Hearing, adopt Ordinance No. 567.3.

BACKGROUND: This amendment to Ordinance No. 567 includes minor cleanup, as well as a revision to Sections 5 and 8 (regarding fees) to correctly reference Ordinance No. 640, the fee ordinance for the Department of Environmental Health.
