1. The accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at 22411 Old Elsinore Road, Perris, Riverside County, California, APN: 323-070-025 be declared a public nuisance and a violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 (Riverside County Code Chapter 8.120).
2. Veronica D. Aguirre, the owner of the subject real property, be directed to abate the accumulation of rubbish on the property by removing the same from the real property within ninety (90) days.

3. If the owner of the real property does not take the above described action within ninety (90) days of the date of the Board's Order to Abate, that representatives of the Code Enforcement Department, Sheriff's Department, and/or a contractor, upon consent or receipt of a Court Order authorizing entry onto the real property when necessary under applicable law, shall abate the accumulation of rubbish by removing and disposing of the same from the real property.
4. The reasonable costs of abatement, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the real property, which may be collected as a special assessment against the real property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance No. 725.
5. County Counsel be directed to prepare the necessary Findings of Fact and Conclusions that the accumulation of rubbish on the real property is declared to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541, and a public nuisance, and further, to prepare an Order to Abate for approval by the Board.

**JUSTIFICATION:**

1. An initial inspection was made of the subject property by Code Enforcement Officers on April 1, 2008.
2. The inspection revealed the accumulation of rubbish on the subject property in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541. The items included but were not limited to: tires, household trash, wood, metal, mattresses, furniture, furniture parts, piping, broken tools, siding, plastics, burn debris, toys, foam, a toilet, pallets, clothing, plastic and miscellaneous debris.
3. Subsequent follow up inspections of the above-described real property on June 17, 2008, November 24, 2008, July 7, 2009, and October 8, 2009 revealed that the property continued to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541.
4. Staff and the Code Enforcement Department have complied with the notice requirements set forth in the appropriate laws of this jurisdiction pertaining to the administrative abatement proceedings for the removal of accumulated rubbish.
