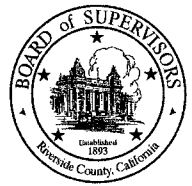

RECOMMENDED MOTION:**


That the Board of Supervisors:
