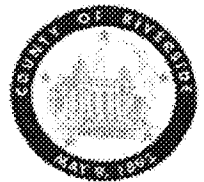



1. The excess outside storage of materials on the real property located at 1 Parcel East of 22312 River Road, Perris, Riverside County, California, APN: 349-440-030 be declared a public nuisance and a violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 348 (Riverside County Code Chapter 17.16).
2. Leilani C. Friedt, the owner of the subject real property, be directed to abate the excess outside storage on the property by removing the same from the real property within ninety (90) days.

Abatement of Public Nuisances

Case No. CV 07-8065

1 Parcel East of 22312 River Road, Perris

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3. If the owner of the real property does not take the above described action within ninety (90) days of the date of the Board's Order to Abate, that representatives of the Code Enforcement Department, Sheriff's Department, and/or a contractor, upon consent or receipt of a Court Order authorizing entry onto the real property when necessary under applicable law, shall abate the excess outside storage by removing the same from the real property.
4. The reasonable costs of abatement, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the real property, which may be collected as a special assessment against the real property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance No. 725.
5. County Counsel be directed to prepare the necessary Findings of Fact and Conclusions that the excess outside storage of materials on the real property is declared to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 348, and a public nuisance, and further, to prepare and Order to Abate for approval by the Board.

JUSTIFICATION:

1. An initial inspection was made of the subject property by the Code Enforcement Officer on July 16, 2008.
2. The inspection revealed the excess outside storage of materials or junkyard on the subject property in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 348. The items included but were not limited to: boats, trailers, scrap metal, metal barrels, auto parts, accessories for heavy construction equipment, tractor, golf carts, plastics, housing components, lumber, scrap wood, glass, wood garage doors, tires, metal piping, aluminum siding and other miscellaneous items.
3. Subsequent re-inspections of the above-described real property on October 3, 2008, May 19, 2009, July 21, 2009, September 12, 2009 and December 1, 2009 revealed that the property continued to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 348.
4. Staff and the Code Enforcement Department have complied with the notice requirements set forth in the appropriate laws of this jurisdiction pertaining to the Administrative Abatement Proceedings for the removal of excess outside storage.
