BACKGROUND:

On December 1, 2009 this Board received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer in the above-referenced matter. At the conclusion of the hearing, this Board declared the accumulation of rubbish located on the subject property to be a public nuisance. The Board ordered the property owner to abate the violative conditions on the property and directed County Counsel to prepare the Findings of Fact, Conclusion and Order to Abate.

20	Assessor's Parcel Number 345-140-032 referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY."		
21	Julie Jarvi, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Brian Black, Supervising Code		
22	Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement Department.		
23	No one appeared on behalf of owner.		
24	The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of Code Enforcement Officer together		
25	with the attached exhibits, evidencing the accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as a public		
26	nuisance and violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541, as codified in Riverside County Code		
27	Chapter 8.120.

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS AND ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

- 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the OWNER of THE PROPERTY as Jacqueline Marie Channer ("OWNER").
- 2. Documents of title indicate that other parties may potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY, to-wit: JenifferFigueria, Carby Gleason, Andrew Wallet, Esq., and Chicago Title Co. ("INTERESTED PARTIES").
- 3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on August 6, 2008, November 20, 2008, March 3, 2009, May 13, 2009, August 7, 2009, November 12, 2009, and November 30, 2009.
- 4. During each inspection, an accumulation of rubbish was observed on THE PROPERTY. The rubbish consisted of, but was not limited to: scrap wood, torn up furniture, tires and trash.
- 5. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120) by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 6. A Notice of Noncompliance was recorded in the Office of the County Recorder, County of Riverside, State of California on June 5, 2009 as instrument number 2009-0287300.
- 7. On August 6, 2008, Notice of Violation was posted on THE PROPERTY. On August 21, 2008, January 13, 2009, March 9, 2009, and June 11, 2009, a Notice of Violation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested to OWNER. On January 13, 2009, a Notice of Violation was mailed by certified mail return receipt requested to INTERESTED PARTIES.
- 8. On October 29, 2009, a "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance" providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors on December 1, 2009 was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the OWNER and INTERESTED PARTIES and posted on THE PROPERTY on November 12, 2009.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on December 1, 2009 finds and concludes that:

1. WHEREAS, the accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at 22705 Shaw

Court, Perris, Riverside County, California, also identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 345-140-032 violates Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 and constitutes a public nuisance.

- 2. WHEREAS, THE OWNER, or any person having possession or control of the premises should abate the condition by removing and disposing all accumulated rubbish from the subject real property in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120) within ninety (90) days.
- 3. WHEREAS, THE OWNER AND INTERESTED PARTIES ARE HEREBY FURTHER NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations made herein must be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by <u>California Code of Civil Procedure</u> Section 1094.6.

ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY be abated by THE OWNER or anyone having possession or control of THE PROPERTY, by removing and disposing of all rubbish from the subject real property in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120) within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the rubbish is not removed and disposed of in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 541, within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance, the rubbish shall be abated and disposed of by representatives of the Riverside County Code Enforcement, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of an owner's consent or a Court Order authorizing entry onto THE PROPERTY when necessary under applicable law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reasonable abatement costs, after notice and opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on THE PROPERTY, which may be collected as a special assessment against THE PROPERTY pursuant to Government Code section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 541 and 725. Under Riverside County Ordinance No. 725, "abatement costs" means "any costs or expenses reasonably related to the abatement of conditions which violate

1	County Land Use Ordinances, and shall include, but not be limited to, enforcement, investigation,
2	collection and administrative costs, attorneys fees, and the costs associated with the removal or
3	correction of the violation." Reasonable abatement costs accrued by the Code Enforcement
4	Department will be recoverable from the property owner(s) even if THE PROPERTY is brought into
5	compliance within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance.
