SUBJECT: Highgrove Backbone Sewer Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Directors approve the Plans and Specifications for the Highgrove Backbone Sewer Project and authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids for the Project.

BACKGROUND:

The Highgrove community lacks sewer infrastructure for existing residents and new development. The Redevelopment Agency has determined that without Agency assistance, this infrastructure cannot be developed. The proposed project will provide for the construction of a new gravity sewer main to be connected to the City of Riverside's wastewater system. Specific improvements to be constructed in this phase consist of approximately 6,300 linear feet of sewer main along a portion of East La Cadena to Center Street then easterly on Center Street to Michigan.
