

**BACKGROUND:** Riverside County Board of Supervisors and Stater Bros. Supermarkets in partnership with Salvation Army and FIND Food Bank have launched, for the second year, an urgently needed food drive campaign to help local families who are faced with hunger this holiday season. During last year's food drive campaign Riverside County EDA collected over \$140,000 worth of food in monetary donations, and over 17 tons of food in the 113 55-gallon food bins placed in 46 Stater Bros. Supermarkets. The website [www.rcfooddrive.org](http://www.rcfooddrive.org) received over 124,000 hits by the community and interested parties.
