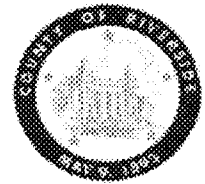

BACKGROUND:

On December 15, 2009 this Board received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer in the above-referenced matter. At the conclusion of the hearing, this Board declared the accumulation of rubbish located on the subject property to be a public nuisance. The Board ordered the property owner to abate the violative conditions on the property and directed County Counsel to prepare the Findings of Fact, Conclusion and Order to Abate.

16 The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on December 15, 2009, before the
17 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor
18 Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real
19 property described as One Parcel North of 15925 Via Vista, Desert Hot Springs, Riverside County,
20 and further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 656-112-016 referred to hereinafter as "THE
21 PROPERTY."

22 Julie Jarvi, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Brian Black, Supervising Code
23 Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement Department.

24 No one appeared on behalf of owner.

25 The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of Code Enforcement Officer together
26 with the attached exhibits, evidencing the accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as a public
27 nuisance and violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541, as codified in Riverside County Code
28 Chapter 8.120.

1 **SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE**

2 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the OWNER
3 of THE PROPERTY as Bill Tripoli ("OWNER").

4 2. THE PROPERTY was inspected by the Code Enforcement Technician on June 17,
5 2009, July 2, 2009, August 4, 2009, October 7, 2009 and December 14, 2009.

6 3. During each inspection, an accumulation of rubbish was observed on THE
7 PROPERTY. The rubbish consisted of, but was not limited to: household rubbish, spent building
8 materials, green waste, tires, broken furniture and a television and miscellaneous household items.

9 4. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance
10 No. 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120) by the Code Enforcement Officer.

11 5. A Notice of Noncompliance was recorded in the Office of the County Recorder,
12 County of Riverside, State of California on June 30, 2009 as instrument number 2009-0336827.

13 7. On June 17, 2009 and July 2, 2009, Notices of Violation were posted on THE
14 PROPERTY. On June 24, 2009, Notice of Violation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt
15 requested to OWNER.

16 8. On October 6, 2009, a "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate
17 Public Nuisance" providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors on December
18 15, 2009 was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the OWNER and posted on THE
19 PROPERTY on October 7, 2009.

20 **FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

21 WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in
22 regular session assembled on December 15, 2009 finds and concludes that:

23 1. WHEREAS, the accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at One Parcel
24 North of 15925 Via Vista, Desert Hot Springs, Riverside County, California, also identified as
25 Assessor's Parcel Number 656-112-016 violates Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 and constitutes
26 a public nuisance.

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1 Department will be recoverable from the property owner(s) even if THE PROPERTY is brought into
2 compliance within ten (10) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance.
