Term of Appointment:

On June 9, 2009 the Board of Supervisors amended the membership section (Section 5, subsection B.) of Ordinance 784 to reflect the appointment of six Commissioners and six Alternate Commissioners. Each member of the Board of Supervisors is to appoint one Commissioner and one alternate with the sixth being an At-Large appointment by the entire Board. These appointments are in addition to those of a member of the Board of Supervisors, the County Health Officer, and an individual responsible for the management of one of several enumerated County functions. The Alternate Commissioners will also serve as Advisory Committee members, in compliance with Proposition 10 statutes.

In accordance with Ordinance 784, a Commissioner or Alternate may serve two terms. After the initial

The Ordinance specifies the qualifications for appointment, which includes a representative of community based organizations that have the goal of promoting nurturing and early childhood development.
