
## SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS **COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**SUBJECT:** Approval of a Riverside County CAL-ID Personnel Change

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the transfer of a Deputy Sheriff position to Riverside County CAL-ID.

BACKGROUND: Riverside County CAL-ID's current implementation of the Mobile ID and FAST-ID programs, and future programs such as facial and tattoo recognition, Homeland Security database access, and mobile misdemeanor booking all have issues that are directly related to field operations. Issues such as mobile device designs and proper device usage are more effectively addressed by a sworn peace officer as opposed to a civilian who would have no experience or background in law enforcement. Therefore, staff requests a Deputy Sheriff addition in CAL-ID, rather than filling one of its five currently vacant classified positions. The CAL-ID Remote Access Network Board approved this personnel action on November 5, 2009.

Sheriff's staff has identified a Deputy Sheriff position to transfer to CAL-ID, which will reduce net County cost for the Department. No budget adjustments are necessary, since the Unit has ample cost savings from the position vacancies.
