

Each member of the Board of Supervisors is to appoint one Commissioner and one alternate with the sixth being an At-Large appointment by the entire Board. These appointments are in addition to those of a member of the Board of Supervisors, the County Health Officer, and an individual responsible for the management of one of several enumerated County functions. The Alternate Commissioners will also serve as Advisory Committee members, in compliance with Proposition 10 statutes.

The Ordinance specifies the qualifications for appointment, which includes a representative of a Local Organization for Prevention or Early Intervention for Families at Risk in Riverside County. Ms. Franklin is a board member for the San Geronio Child Care Consortium, a member of the Riverside County Child Care Consortium, a commissioner of the Community Action Partnership and is a council member with the City of Banning. Ms. Franklin has also been a member of the First 5 Riverside Advisory Committee since June 2009. Mr. Franklin's experience with child care issues as well as issues concerning poverty and community development will be a tremendous asset to the Riverside County Children and Families Commission. Ms. Franklin will serve as an Alternate to Commissioner Jay Hoffman.
