
SUBJECT: Naming of the Romoland Community Center

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

Name the community center project in the Homeland/Romoland area the "Marion V. Ashley Community Center."

Background: This project came about from Supervisor Ashley's desire to provide a new facility for the community of Homeland and Romoland. The project is located on a 12-acre site at the southwest corner of Watson and Briggs Roads in the City of Menifee. The project will entail an approximately 15,000 square foot community center with a 12-acre park surrounding the building site. The community center will include a multi-use gymnasium with basketball and volleyball amenities, multi-purpose rooms and a daycare.

In recognition of Supervisor Ashley's long standing roots in this community, having attending grammar school in Romoland and his dedication to providing need facilities and childcare services to the community it is with great honor that this new building be named in his honor.
