
**SUBJECT:** Fifth District Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for the Transportation and Land Management Agency (TLMA);
2. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

Decrease Board Designations: 10000-1000100000-320135	Community Improvement	\$10,000
Increase Appropriations: 10000-1000100000-551100	Contributions to Other Funds	\$10,000
Increase Estimated Revenue 20200-3100100000-790600	Contributions from Other Funds	\$10,000
Increase Appropriations: 20200-3100100000-525440	Professional Services	\$10,000

**BACKGROUND:** In an effort to stimulate the local economy, the County has taken aggressive action to reduce our Development Impact Fees (DIF) and Western County Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fees (TUMF). It is important for the County to understand its competitive position by comparing our DIF fees against other cities and counties within the Inland Empire. This contribution will allow TLMA to contract with Development Research to perform the DIF comparison analysis and provide feedback to this board.
