**SUBJECT:** Single/Sole Source Payment for State Certified training, Rescue Systems II, from Riverside County Training Officers' Association (RCTOA)

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors Approve the single/sole source payment for the purchase of State Certified training, Rescue Systems II class, without securing competitive bids, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459.4 in the amount of \$27,600 from Riverside County Training Officers' Association (RCTOA) and pursuant to the Purchasing Agent approving this purchase on behalf of the County.

**BACKGROUND:** The Riverside County Training Officers Association (RCTOA) provided instructor services, student materials, books and certificates of completion of the State of California Certified training, Rescue Systems II class for forty-four fire safety personnel during the period of November 30, 2009 through December 4, 2009 with a total cost of \$27,600. The funding for this class is 100% reimbursable provided by the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) for Grant Year 2007.

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Rescue System II Class from RCTOA

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**BACKGROUND (continued):** The Rescue Systems II class is specialized training, very specific in nature and offered by a limited number of local resources. Instructors as well as training sites for Rescue Systems II must be State of California Fire Marshall authorized and approved to obtain the State Certifications of completion. Going beyond the local area for this training would adversely affect the cost of providing the training and incur additional expenses such as travel, lodging and per diem.

**PRICE REASONABLENESS:** The pricing per student and total class pricing is comparable with the same classes offered elsewhere in the State of California at State Fire Marshall approved sites. The vendor listed has given Riverside County Fire price reductions in the form of "No Charge" for use of approved sites.

The end result will be a benefit to the County of Riverside by increasing the number of Public Safety Personnel trained in these specialized techniques for disaster emergency rescues.
