SUBJECT: Adoption of Resolution #2010-063 Authorizing the Sheriff's Department to

Submit a Grant Application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution #2010-063, which authorizes the Sheriff or designee to sign and submit a grant application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation for \$125,000 to continue off-highway vehicle (OHV) law enforcement efforts in Riverside County and expand enforcement by targeting sites in the unincorporated areas of all five Supervisorial Districts.

BACKGROUND: The California Department of Parks and Recreation is currently accepting grant applications for its Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program. On September 10, 2002 (3.32), the Board approved two Project Agreements with the Department for a County off-highway motor vehicle enforcement program. Christened the Riverside Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program (R.O.V.E.), this innovative and effective program has put Deputies on all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) to enforce laws concerning illegal off-highway driving, dumping, driving under the influence and environmental destruction. The Board accepted grant funds and approved project grant agreements to continue this effort for the following years: April 27, 2004 (3.18), July 12, 2005 (3.58), October 2, 2007 (3.57), March 11, 2008 (3.45) and March 24, 2009 (3.18).

The current application will begin Phase VII of the Sheriff's county-wide effort by expanding enforcement efforts in all five Supervisorial Districts with a proposed start date of September 2010. The application requests \$125,000 to support Deputy Sheriff overtime for continued and expanded patrols in problematic areas.

The grant application requires a 25% match of the total project cost of \$166,667 in the amount of \$41,667. The Department proposes contributing an in-kind match of Special Enforcement Bureau salaries. All local match contributions will come from the Department's status quo budget. Any grant awarded will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for review and approval.

During the development of this phase of the county-wide project, the Sheriff requested public comment via a posting on the Department's web site and through mailings to interested individuals.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATION FOR STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS - LAW ENFORCEMENT AND EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, The people of the State of California have enacted the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Act of 2003, which provides funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for, Acquisition Projects, Conservation Projects, Development Projects, Facilities Operation and Maintenance Projects, Law Enforcement Projects OHV Safety and/or Education Program Projects, Planning Projects, Restoration Projects, and Trail Maintenance Projects for off-highway vehicle recreation; and

WHEREAS, procedures established by the California Department of Parks and Recreation require the Applicant's Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of the Application to apply for Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Grant; funds; and

WHEREAS, this Project appears on, or is in conformance with this jurisdiction's adopted general or master plan and is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on at 9:00 a.m. in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors, located on the 1st

floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, CA, approves the filing of an Application(s) for an Off-Highway Vehicle Grant or Cooperative Agreement and;

- 1. Certifies that Riverside County understands its legal obligations to the State upon approval of the Grant; and
- Certifies that Riverside County understands the California Public Resources Code requirement that acquisition and development Projects be maintained to specific conservation standards; and
- 3. Certifies that the Project will be well-maintained during its useful life; and
- Certifies that Riverside County will implement the Project with diligence once funds are available and the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees with the Project Agreement; and
- 5. Certifies that the County will provide the required Matching Funds (as applicable) in the event that it accepts the award; and
- 6. Certifies that the public and adjacent property owners have been notified of this Project (as applicable); and
- 7. Appoints the Sheriff or designee as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to Applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for completion of the Project.
