SUBJECT: Approval of the Amendment to the Professional Medical Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and Loma Linda University School of Dentistry/Special Care Dentistry

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

- 1) Ratify the amendment to the agreement with Loma Linda University School of Dentistry/Special Care Dentistry effective January 1, 2010;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to sign three (3) copies of the amendment;
- 3) Retain one (1) copy and return two (2) copies of the executed amendments RCRMC for distribution.

BACKGROUND: Effective February 1, 2007, RCRMC was awarded a grant from the Riverside County Children and Families Commission, also known as First 5 Riverside, to provide dental screening and education services to children less than 5 years of age at school sites and health fairs. The grant was renewed and funding increased effective July 1, 2009. As a result of this funding increase, increased restorative services can be provided to children requiring dental care. Loma Linda University School of Dentistry/Special Care Dentistry has agreed to provide additional dental care and oral surgery services.

This Agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

In consideration of services provided by CONTRACTOR, pursuant to this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be entitled to receive payment by HOSPITAL for all authorized services in accordance with HOSPITAL policy and procedures as follows:

1.0 Professional Services

- Dental examination and treatment Denti-Cal + 10%
- Diagnostic radiographs Denti-Cal + 10%

- Oral Sedation 1st Visit \$100
- Oral Sedation Subsequent Visits* \$ 75
- Nitrous Oxide analgesia Denti-Cal + 10%
- General Anesthesia \$500

* maximum of four (4) consecutive visits per patient

All services are considered inclusive of technical fees charged by dental office.

1 **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT**
2 **BETWEEN**
3 **RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER**
4 **AND**
5 **LOMA LINDA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY/SPECIAL CARE**
6 **DENTISTRY**

7 This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the County of
8 Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to
9 as COUNTY, on behalf of Riverside County Regional Medical Center, hereinafter
10 referred to as HOSPITAL, and Loma Linda University School of Dentistry/Special
11 Care Dentistry, a not for profit educational institution hereinafter referred to as
12 CONTRACTOR.

13 WHEREAS, Government Code Section 31000 authorizes the HOSPITAL
14 to contract for outpatient Pediatric Dental Professional services to be provided by
15 persons/entities who are specially trained, experienced and competent to
16 perform the services required;

17 WHEREAS, HOSPITAL desires to obtain outpatient Dental Screening,
18 Treatment and Dental Surgical services not available on-site at HOSPITAL
19 facilities to perform specialized dental treatment as part of the Dental Disease
20 Prevention Program for the First 5 Program for patients that the HOSPITAL
21 maintains the responsibility to provide and coordinate medical care and medical
22 services;

23 WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR has the expertise, special skills, knowledge
24 and experience to perform the duties set out herein;

25 NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants
representations and conditions hereinafter contained, the PARTIES hereto
mutually agree as follows.

1 **1.0 DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:**

2 CONTRACTOR will provide outpatient Dental Screening,
3 Treatment and Dental Surgical services as outlined in Attachment A, attached
4 hereto and made part of the Agreement.

5 **2.0 TERM AND TERMINATION:**

6 2.1 TERM. This Agreement shall be effective as of August 1,
7 2008 through June 30, 2009 and automatically continue on a year-to-year basis,
8 unless terminated as specified below in Section 2.2 or as otherwise specified
9 herein.

10 2.2 TERMINATION WITHOUT CAUSE. Either party may
11 terminate this Agreement with or without cause by giving ninety (90) days prior
12 written notice to the other party.

13 2.2.1 In the event of termination of this Agreement,
14 CONTRACTOR shall continue to provide and be compensated for Dental
15 Surgery under the terms of this Agreement to patients who have been authorized
16 for treatment on the date of termination until the effective date of discharge of
17 care or the safe transfer of such patients to another Health Care Provider, or a
18 period of ninety (90) days, whichever comes first.

19 2.3 NON-AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS. In the event of non-
20 availability of COUNTY funds, this Agreement shall be deemed terminated and
21 have no further force and effect immediately on receipt of COUNTY's notification
22 to CONTRACTOR.
23

24 **3.0 COMPENSATION:**

25 3.1 In consideration of services provided by CONTRACTOR

1 pursuant to this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be entitled to receive payment
2 in accordance with HOSPITAL policy and procedure. CONTRACTOR shall
3 submit complete and accurate claims to HOSPITAL within one hundred and
4 twenty (120) days from the date of service. Claims must be submitted on a
5 Universal Billing Form (UB92), HCFA 1500 Form or its successor claim form.
6 CONTRACTOR shall not seek payment for claims submitted after one (1) year
7 from the date of service. CONTRACTOR shall accept the payments for services
8 as described above in Section 1.0 and specified in Attachment A, attached
9 hereto, as payment in full.

10 3.2 Maximum payments to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed
11 forty thousand (\$40,000) dollars per year. Payments to CONTRACTOR shall be
12 made on a monthly basis during the Term of this Agreement.

13 **4.0 HOLD HARMLESS-INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR:**

14 4.1 CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and hold harmless all
15 Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments of the County of Riverside,
16 their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed
17 officials, employees, agents and representatives from any liability whatsoever,
18 based or asserted upon any services of CONTRACTOR, its offices, employees,
19 subcontractors, agents or representatives resulting from this Agreement,
20 including but not limited to property damage, bodily injury, or death or any other
21 element of any kind or nature whatsoever and resulting from the performance of
22 CONTRACTOR, its offices, agents, employees, subcontractors, agents or
23 representatives from this Agreement; CONTRACTOR shall defend, at its sole
24 expense, all costs and fees including but not limited to attorney fees, cost of
25 investigation, defense and

1 settlements or awards all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments
2 of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of
3 Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and
4 representatives in any claims or action based upon such alleged acts or
5 omissions.

6 4.2 With respect to any action or claim subject to indemnification
7 herein by CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR shall, at their sole cost, have the right
8 to use counsel of their own choice and shall have the right to adjust, settle, or
9 compromise any such action or claim without the prior consent of COUNTY;
10 provided, however, that any such adjustment, settlement or compromise in no
11 manner whatsoever limits or circumstances CONTRACTOR'S indemnification to
12 COUNTY as set forth herein. CONTRACTOR'S obligation to defend, indemnify
13 and hold harmless COUNTY shall be subject to COUNTY having given
14 CONTRACTOR written notice within a reasonable period of time of the claim or
15 the commencement of the related action, as the case may be, and information
16 and reasonable assistance, at CONTRACTOR'S expense, for the defense or
17 settlement thereof. CONTRACTOR'S obligation hereunder shall be satisfied
18 when CONTRACTOR has provided to COUNTY the appropriate form of
19 dismissal relieving COUNTY from any liability for the action or claim involved.

20 4.3 The specified insurance limits required in this Agreement
21 shall in no way limit or circumscribe CONTRACTOR'S obligation to indemnify
22 and hold harmless the COUNTY herein from third party claims.

23 4.4 In the event there is conflict between this clause and
24 California Civil Code Section 2782, this clause shall not be interpreted to comply
25 with Civil Code 2782. Such interpretation shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR

1 from indemnifying the COUNTY to the fullest extent allowed by law.

2 **5.0 INSURANCE:**

3 5.1 Without limiting or diminishing the CONTRACTOR'S
4 obligation to indemnify or hold the HOSPITAL harmless, CONTRACTOR shall
5 procure and maintain or cause to be maintained, at its sole cost and expense,
6 the following insurance and/or self- insurance coverages during the term of this
7 Agreement.

8 5.2 WORKERS' COMPENSATION

9 If the CONTRACTOR has employees as defined by the State of
10 California, the CONTRACTOR shall maintain statutory Workers' Compensation
11 Insurance (Coverage A) and/or self insurance as prescribed by the laws of the
12 State of California. Policy shall include Employers' Liability (Coverage B)
13 including Occupational Disease with limits not less than **\$1,000,000** per person
14 per accident. The policy shall be endorsed to waive subrogation in favor of The
15 County of Riverside, and, if applicable, to provide a Borrowed Servant/Alternate
16 Employer Endorsement to the extent coverage is provided by a commercial
17 insurance policy.

18 5.3 COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY

19 Commercial General Liability insurance and/or program of self-
20 insurance coverage, including but not limited to, premises liability, contractual
21 liability, products and completed operations liability, personal and advertising
22 injury covering claims which may arise from or out of CONTRACTOR'S
23 performance of its obligations hereunder. Policy shall name all Agencies,
24 Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of Riverside, their
25 respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees, elected or

1 appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insureds to the extent
2 coverage is provided by a commercial insurance policy. Policy's limit of liability
3 shall not be less than **\$1,000,000** per occurrence combined single limit. If such
4 insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this
5 agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit.

6 5.4 VEHICLE LIABILITY

7 If CONTRACTOR'S vehicles or mobile equipment are used in the
8 performance of the obligations under this Agreement, then CONTRACTOR shall
9 maintain liability insurance to the extent coverage is provided by a commercial
10 insurance policy for all owned, non-owned or hired vehicles so used in an
11 amount not less than **\$1,000,000** per occurrence combined single limit. If such
12 insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this
13 agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit. Policy shall
14 name all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of
15 Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees,
16 elected or appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insureds to
17 the extent coverage is provided by a commercial insurance policy.

18 5.5 PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

19 Contractor shall maintain Professional Liability insurance of not less
20 than **\$1,000,000** per occurrence and **\$2,000,000** annual aggregate that shall
21 protect from claims, including but not limited to, damages for contractual liability
22 which may arise from or out of **Contractor's** performance of it obligations
23 hereunder, whether such use or performance be by **Contractor**, **Contractor**
24 subcontracted personnel, or by anyone professionally employed directly or
25 indirectly by any of them. **Contractor** may satisfy this insurance requirement

1 through a program of self-insurance.

2 5.6 GENERAL INSURANCE PROVISIONS – ALL LINES

3 1) Any insurance carrier providing insurance coverage to
4 the extent coverage is provided by a commercial insurance carrier hereunder
5 shall be admitted to the State of California and have an A M BEST rating of not
6 less than A: VIII (A:8) unless such requirements are waived, in writing, by the
7 County Risk Manager. If the County's Risk Manager waives a requirement for a
8 particular insurer such waiver is only valid for that specific insurer and only for
9 one policy term.

10 2) The CONTRACTOR'S insurance carrier(s) must
11 declare its insurance deductibles or self-insured retentions. If such deductibles
12 or self-insured retentions exceed \$500,000 per occurrence such deductibles
13 and/or retentions shall have the prior written consent of the County Risk Manager
14 before the commencement of operations under this Agreement. Upon
15 notification of deductibles or self insured retentions unacceptable to the
16 COUNTY, and at the election of the Country's Risk Manager, CONTRACTOR'S
17 carriers shall either; 1) reduce or eliminate such deductibles or self-insured
18 retention's as respects this Agreement with the HOSPITAL, or 2) procure a bond,
19 which guarantees payment of losses and related investigations, claims
20 administration, and defense costs and expenses.

21 3) CONTRACTOR shall cause CONTRACTOR'S
22 insurance carrier(s) to furnish the County of Riverside with either; 1) a properly
23 executed original Certificate(s) of Insurance and certified original copies of
24 Endorsements effecting coverage as required herein, and 2) if requested to do so
25 orally or in writing by the County Risk Manager, provide original Certified copies

1 of policies including all Endorsements and all attachments thereto, showing such
2 insurance is in full force and effect. Further, said Certificate(s) and policies of
3 insurance shall contain the covenant of the insurance carrier(s) that thirty (30)
4 days written notice shall be given to the County of Riverside prior to any material
5 modification, cancellation, expiration or reduction in coverage of such insurance.

6 In the event of a material modification, cancellation, expiration, or reduction in
7 coverage, this Agreement shall terminate forthwith, unless the County of
8 Riverside receives, prior to such effective date, another properly executed
9 original Certificate of Insurance and original copies of endorsements or certified
10 original policies, including all endorsements and attachments thereto evidencing
11 coverage's set forth herein and the insurance required herein is in full force and
12 effect. **CONTRACTOR shall not commence operations until the COUNTY**
13 **has been furnished original Certificate (s) of Insurance and certified**
14 **original copies of endorsements and if requested, certified original policies**
15 **of insurance including all endorsements and any and all other attachments**
16 **as required in this Section. An individual authorized by the insurance**
17 **carrier to do so on its behalf shall sign the original endorsements for each**
18 **policy and the Certificate of Insurance.**

19 4) It is understood and agreed to by the parties hereto
20 and the insurance company(s), that the Certificate(s) of Insurance and policies
21 shall so covenant and shall be construed as primary insurance, and the
22 COUNTY'S insurance and/or deductibles and/or self-insured retention's or self-
23 insured programs shall not be construed as contributory.

24 5) The COUNTY'S Reserved Rights--Insurance. If,
25 during the term of this Agreement or any extension thereof, there is a material

1 change in the scope of services; the COUNTY reserves the right to adjust the
2 types of insurance required under this Agreement and the monetary limits of
3 liability for the insurance coverage's currently required herein, if, in the County
4 Risk Manager's reasonable judgment, the amount or type of insurance carried by
5 the CONTRACTOR has become inadequate.

6 6) CONTRACTOR shall pass down the insurance
7 obligations contained herein to all tiers of subcontractors working under this
8 Agreement.

9 7) The insurance requirements contained in this
10 Agreement may be met with a program of self-insurance or a combination of
11 insurance and self-insurance.

12 **6.0 AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING:**

13 The HOSPITAL obligation for payment of any contract beyond the
14 current fiscal year end is contingent upon the availability of funding from which
15 payment can be made. No legal liability on the part of the HOSPITAL shall arise
16 for payment beyond June 30 of the calendar year unless funds are made
17 available for such performance.

18 **7.0 RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS:**

19 7.1 CONTRACTOR shall make available, upon written request
20 by and duly authorized Federal, State or COUNTY agency, a copy of this
21 Agreement and such books, documents and records as are necessary to certify
22 the nature and extent of the costs of the services provided by CONTRACTOR.
23 CONTRACTOR shall maintain books and records for at least five (5) years from
24 the termination of this Agreement.

25 7.2 CONTRACTOR agrees to provide HOSPITAL with reports

1 and information relative to this Agreement and in accordance with terms set forth
2 herein, as may be requested by HOSPITAL.

3 **8.0 CONFIDENTIALITY:**

4 CONTRACTOR agrees to protect from unauthorized disclosure
5 names and other identifying information concerning either persons receiving
6 services under this Agreement or persons whose names or other identifying
7 information becomes known to CONTRACTOR as a result of services performed
8 under this Agreement, except statistical information not identifying any such
9 person.

10 8.1 CONTRACTOR shall not disclose, except as otherwise
11 specifically permitted by this Agreement or authorized by the client or client's
12 representative, any such identifying information to anyone other than authorized
13 HOSPITAL personnel without prior written authorization from the HOSPITAL.

14 8.2 For the purpose of this paragraph, "identify" shall include, but
15 not be limited to, name, identifying number, symbol, or other identifying particular
16 assigned to the individual, such as finger or voiceprint or photograph.

17 8.3 CONTRACTOR shall observe all Federal, State and
18 COUNTY laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, the Health Insurance
19 Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) of 1996, concerning the security and
20 privacy of patient records and information.

21 **9.0 LICENSE:**

22 CONTRACTOR shall, through the Term of this Agreement, maintain
23 all licenses necessary for the provision of the services hereunder and required by
24 the laws and regulations of the United States, the State of California, County of
25 Riverside, and all other governmental agencies. CONTRACTOR shall notify

1 HOSPITAL immediately, in writing, of inability to obtain or maintain such license.

2 Said inability shall be cause for termination of this Agreement.

3 9.1 CONTRACTOR shall ensure that CONTRACTOR'S
4 employees, agents, and subcontractors performing services under the terms of
5 this Agreement are in compliance with all relative licensing requirements.
6 CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to notify HOSPITAL immediately, in writing, of
7 inability of CONTRACTOR or any of CONTRACTOR'S employees, agents and
8 subcontractors to obtain or maintain such license(s). Said inability shall be cause
9 for termination of this Agreement.

10 9.2 COPY REQUIRED. A copy of each such license, permit,
11 approval, waiver, exemption, registration, accreditation, and certificate shall be
12 provided to Contracts Administration, upon request.

13 9.3 Further, CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to abide by the
14 standards of medical practice of the profession when performing services
15 hereunder.

16 **10.0 NONDISCRIMINATION AND ELIGIBILITY:**

17 The CONTRACTOR shall not unlawfully discriminate in the
18 provision of services, allocation of benefits, accommodation in facilities, or
19 employment of personnel, on the basis of ethnic group identification, race, color,
20 creed, ancestry, religion, national origin, sexual preference, sex, age (over 40),
21 marital status, medical attention, or physical or mental handicap, and shall
22 comply with all other applicable requirements of law regarding non discrimination
23 and affirmative action including
24 those laws pertaining to the prohibition of discrimination against qualified
25 handicapped persons in all programs or activities.

1 10.1 For the purpose of this Agreement, distinctions on the
2 grounds of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, or physical or mental
3 handicap include but are not limited to the following:

4 1. Denying an eligible person or providing to an eligible
5 person any services or benefit which is different, or is provided in a different
6 manner or at a different time from that provided to other eligible persons under
7 this Agreement.

8 2. Subjecting an eligible person to segregation or
9 separate treatment in any matter related to his receipt of any service, except
10 when necessary for infection control.

11 3. Restricting an eligible person differently in any way in
12 the enjoyment of any advantage or privilege enjoyed by others receiving similar
13 service or benefit.

14 4. Treating an eligible person differently from others in
15 determining whether he satisfied any eligibility, membership, or other
16 requirement or condition which individuals must meet in order to be provided a
17 similar service or benefit.

18 5. The assignment of times or places for the provision of
19 services on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, or physical
20 or mental handicap of the eligible person to be served.

21 **11.0 CONFLICT OF INTEREST:**

22 CONTRACTOR and CONTRACTOR'S employees shall have no
23 interest, and shall not acquire any interest, direct or indirect, which will conflict in
24 any manner or degree with the performance of services required under this
25 Agreement.

1 **12.0 ALTERATION:**

2 The Board of Supervisors and the COUNTY Purchasing Agent are
3 the only authorized COUNTY representatives who may at any time, by written
4 order, make alterations within the general scope of this contract, in the definition
5 of services to be performed, and the time (i.e. hours of the day, days of the week,
6 etc.) and place of performance thereof. If any such alteration causes an increase
7 or decrease in the cost of, or the time required for the performance of any part of
8 the work under this contract, an equitable adjustment shall be made in the
9 contract price or delivery schedule, or both, and the contract shall be modified in
10 writing accordingly. Any claim by the CONTRACTOR for adjustment under this
11 paragraph shall be assessed within thirty (30) days of when the CONTRACTOR
12 received notice of the alteration in the work. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the
13 COUNTY Purchasing Agent decides that the facts provide sufficient justification,
14 he/she may receive and act upon any claim, which is asserted by the
15 CONTRACTOR at any time prior to final payment under this Agreement.
16 However, nothing in this clause shall excuse the CONTRACTOR from
17 proceeding with the contract as changed.

18 **13.0 ASSIGNMENT:**

19 CONTRACTOR may not delegate the obligations hereunder, either in
20 whole or in part, without prior written consent of the County Purchasing Agent
21 and the HOSPITAL provided, however, obligations undertaken by
22 CONTRACTOR pursuant to this Agreement may be carried out by means of
23 subcontracts if approved by HOSPITAL and the County Purchasing Agent. No
24 subcontract shall terminate or alter the responsibilities of the CONTRACTOR to
25 the HOSPITAL pursuant to this Agreement. CONTRACTOR may not assign the

1 rights hereunder, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the
2 HOSPITAL and the County Purchasing Agent. Any attempted assignment or
3 delegation in derogation of this paragraph shall be void. A change in the
4 business structure of CONTRACTOR, including but not limited to, change in the
5 majority ownership, change in the form of CONTRACTOR'S business
6 organization, management of CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR'S ownership of
7 other business dealing with CONTRACTOR under this Agreement, or filing of
8 bankruptcy by CONTRACTOR, shall be deemed an assignment for purposes of
9 this paragraph.

10 **14.0 ADMINISTRATION:**

11 The HOSPITAL Director/Chief Executive Officer (CEO) (or
12 designee) shall administer this Agreement on behalf of the COUNTY.

13 **15.0 WAIVER:**

14 Any waiver by HOSPITAL of any breach of any one or more of the
15 terms of this Agreement shall not be construed to be a waiver of any subsequent
16 or other breach of the same or of any other term thereof. Failure on the part of
17 the HOSPITAL to require exact, full and complete compliance with any terms of
18 this Agreement shall not be construed as in any manner changing the terms
19 hereof or stopping HOSPITAL from enforcement hereof.

20 **16.0 JURISDICTION, VENUE, ATTORNEY FEES:**

21 This Agreement and its contraction and interpretation as to validity,
22 performance and breach shall be construed under the laws of the State of
23 California. Any legal action related to this Agreement shall be filed in the
24 appropriate court (Municipal or Superior) of the State of California located in
25 Riverside, California.

1 **17.0 SEVERABILITY:**

2 In the event any provision in this Agreement is held by a court of
3 competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining
4 provisions will nevertheless continue in full force without being impaired or
5 invalidated in any way.

6 **18.0 CAPTIONS AND PARAGRAPH HEADINGS:**

7 Captions and paragraph headings used in this Agreement are for
8 convenience only and are not a part of this Agreement and shall not be used in
9 construing this Agreement.

21 **20.0 Independent Contractor**

22 The CONTRACTOR is, for purposes arising out of this contract, an
23 Independent CONTRACTOR and shall not be deemed an employee of the
24 County. It is expressly understood and agreed that the CONTRACTOR shall in
25 no event, as a result of this contract, be entitled to any benefits to which

1 it under this Agreement.

2 23.0 Conduct of Contractor

3 1) The CONTRACTOR agrees to inform the COUNTY of all the
4 CONTRACTOR'S interest, if any, which are or which the CONTRACTOR
5 believes to be incompatible with any interest of the COUNTY.

6 2) The CONTRACTOR shall not, under circumstances, which
7 might reasonably be interpreted as an attempt to influence the recipient in the
8 conduct of his duties, accept any gratuity or special favor from individuals or
9 organizations with whom the CONTRACTOR is doing business or proposing to
10 do business, in accomplishing the work under the contract.

11 3) The CONTRACTOR shall not use for personal gain or make
12 other improper use of privileged information, which is acquired in connection with
13 this Agreement. In this connection, the term "privileged information" includes, but
14 is not limited to, unpublished information relating to technological and scientific
15 development; medical, personnel, or security records of the individuals;
16 anticipated materials requirement or pricing actions; and knowledge of selection
17 of CONTRACTORS or SUBCONTRACTORS in advance of official
18 announcement.

19 4) The CONTRACTOR or employees thereof shall not offer
20 gifts, gratuity, favors, and entertainment directly or indirectly to COUNTY

22 24.0 Disallowance

23 In the event the CONTRACTOR receives payment for services
24 under this Agreement, which is later disallowed for nonconformance with the

17 and personnel assigned for services hereunder, or for parties named in the
18 proposal and agreed to under any resulting contract.

19 22.0 Interest of Contractor

20 The CONTRACTOR covenants that it presently has no interest,
21 including but not limited to, other projects or independent contracts, and shall not
22 acquire any such interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner or
23 degree with the performance of services required to be performed under this
24 Agreement. The CONTRACTOR further covenants that in the performance of
25 this Agreement, no person having such interest shall be employed or retained by

1 refund the disallowed amount to the COUNTY on request, or at its option, the
2 COUNTY may offset the amount disallowed for any payment due to the
3 CONTRACTOR under this Agreement.

4 **25.0 Right to Acquire Equipment and Services**

5 Nothing in this Agreement shall prohibit the COUNTY from
6 acquiring the same type or equivalent equipment and/or services for other
7 sources, when deemed by the COUNTY to be in its best interest.

8 **26.0 Force Majeure**

9 In the event CONTRACTOR is unable to comply with any provision
10 of this Agreement due to causes beyond their control such as acts of God acts of
11 war, civil disorders, or other similar acts, CONTRACTOR shall not be held liable
12 to COUNTY for such failure to comply.

13 In the event COUNTY is unable to comply with any provision of this
14 Agreement due to causes beyond their control such as acts of God acts of war,
15 civil disorders, or other similar acts, COUNTY shall not be held liable to
16 CONTRACTOR for such failure to comply.

17 **27.0 EDD Reporting Requirements**

18 In order to comply with child support enforcement requirements of
19 the State of California, the County of Riverside may be required to submit a
20 Report of Independent Contractor(s) form **DE 542** to the Employment
21 Development Department. The selected contractor agrees to furnish the
22 required Contractor data and certifications to the County of Riverside within ten
23 (10) days of notification of award of contract when required by the **EDD**.

24 It is expressly understood that this data will be transmitted to
25 governmental agencies charged with the establishment and enforcement of child

1 support orders and for no other purposes and will be held confidential by those
