SUBJECT: Implementation of a Riverside County Cost Segregation Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the Economic Development Agency (EDA) to partner with the California Association for Local Economic Development (CALED) in implementing a Cost Segregation program; and
2. Authorize the Assistant County Executive Officer/EDA or his designee to execute any documents necessary to implement the program.

BACKGROUND: CALED, a statewide professional economic development organization, has implemented a program for for-profit businesses that own commercial property that analyzes a business' tax strategy as it relates to depreciable building assets. This program will help determine if the appropriate accounting method is being used and, if not, assist the business in identifying the necessary changes to their depreciation methods in order to maximize tax benefits under the law.

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

This program is a result of changes in the tax code that went into effect during the last few years. The potential benefits to a participating business include a tax refund, improved long term cash flow, and compliance with Internal Revenue Service (IRS) codes. CALED has contracted with an industry leader in Cost Segregation Analysis to conduct the studies and receives a fee for referrals generated through CALED and its members. CALED is offering a percentage of the fee they receive to its members who refer businesses that take advantage of the program; EDA is a member of CALED and is therefore eligible. The referral fee that EDA receives would be used to fund economic development, business attraction, and retention programs. The program would be offered to cities throughout the County as part of the Team Riverside County partnership.
