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**BACKGROUND:**

On November 18, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved a Job Order Contract between MTM Construction Inc. and the County of Riverside. A work order was issued pursuant to that contract for RCIT system work. That Project has been inspected and found to comply with all the contract requirements. This Board action will release the contract retention funds of \$19,368 to MTM Construction, Inc.

There were no change orders to the original work order amount. The total approved work order is within the overall project budget and no additional funding is required.
