BACKGROUND:

On October 6, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved an engineering services agreement with MRC Engineering, Inc. of Palm Desert California. The contract documents are complete and EDA requests approval to solicit bids for the project. The plans and specifications have been reviewed by County Counsel and approved as to form.

EDA requests that the Board delegate the authority of awarding the construction agreement to the Department per Board Policy B-11, and authorize the Chairman to execute the construction agreement, provided that the contract amount falls within the proposed project budget. Time is of the essence as RCIT would like to have the work completed by the end of $Ju\gamma$ 2010.

The construction agreement will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder following review and approval of the bid submittals and contract by County Counsel.

Project related expenditures for FY09/10 are estimated at \$326,436. All costs associated with this project will be funded through Tobacco settlement funds to be reimbursed by future CORAL bond proceeds, thus no Net County Cost will be incurred as a result of this agreement.
