Krameria Avenue improvements include construction of a sidewalk on both the north and south side of Krameria Avenue between Lois Lane and Washington Street. All existing obstructions such as fences, road signs, irrigation systems, mailboxes, trees, and water meters will be relocated as needed. Additional improvements such as widening, additional curb and gutter, curb returns, and curb outlets will also be constructed.

Mayberry Avenue improvements include construction of a sidewalk on the south side of Mayberry Avenue between Dartmouth Middle School and Stanford Street. The existing sidewalk ends just east of Dartmouth Middle School and children currently walk in the street to get to School. The proposed sidewalk will provide a safe path of travel to school. Additional safety improvements include the installation of an access ramp at the intersection of Mayberry Avenue and Standford Street.

The bid documents include the following schedules of work:

Schedule A: Primary items of work on Krameria Avenue.

Alternate 1: Krameria Avenue, adjustment and relocation of water meters and fire hydrants, to be funded by the Western Municipal Water District under the

terms of a cooperative agreement, which will be executed prior to or concurrently with the submission of the construction contract for award.

Schedule B: Primary items of work on Mayberry Avenue.

Alternate 2: Mayberry Avenue, relocation of water meters, to be funded by the Lake

Hemet Water District under the terms of a cooperative agreement, which will be executed prior to or concurrently with the submission of the

construction contract for award.

If the utility owners concur with bid prices, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the alternate bid schedules will be included with the contract award and the costs for the work will be funded by that utility owner.

The projects are partially funded with SB 821 funds for which the County successfully competed.


The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.






