BACKGROUND:

On July 31, 2007, the Board of Supervisors approved a pre-qualified list of consultants to be retained on an as-needed basis.

On July 21, 2009, The Economic Development Agency signed an agreement with P2S Engineering, Inc. for their engineering services for the RCRMC Inpatient Treatment Facility Security Cameras and Monitors project located at 9990 County Farm Road in Riverside. The bid documents are now complete and Economic Development Agency (EDA) requests approval to solicit bids for construction of this project.

All costs associated with this project will be funded through RCRMC Operating Funds. No net county cost will be incurred as a result of this agreement.
