RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move that the Board of Supervisors ratify and authorize the Chairman of the Board to approve and execute the attached Amendment(s) to the Agreements between Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) and five Contractors to provide temporary staffing for rehabilitation registry services. The Amendment increases the total aggregate amount to \$330,000 for the period beginning March 1, 2010 through June 30, 2010 for the following:

- Career Staffing Unlimited,
- Medical Staffing Network, Inc.,
- Preferred Healthcare Registry, Inc.,
- Rehababilities, Inc., and
- RPT PRN

BACKGROUND:

In 2006, Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC), entered into a Professional Services Agreement at a uniform rate with Career Staffing Unlimited, Medical Staffing Network, Inc., Preferred Healthcare Registry, Inc., Rehababilities, Inc., and RPT PRN as result of RFP MCARC015 in an

BACKGROUND (Continued):

aggregate amount of \$100,000 to provide temporary staffing for rehabilitation registry services. And on December 1, 2009, Agenda Item Number 3.25, the Board approved to increase the aggregate contract amount to \$250,000 due to the influx of services.

Currently, the hospital utilizes the registries to meet patient care needs in the Occupational and Physical Therapy departments. During fiscal year 2009/2010, the need for rehabilitation registry services has significantly grown and the need continues to grow due to a reduction in permanent staffing. The reduction was attributed to several hospital employees entitled to take the Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA) in addition to maintaining compliance with the mandatory countywide furloughs. The contract increase will allow the hospital to ensure continuity of services by fulfilling physician orders and maintaining compliance with Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and Joint Commission guidelines.

Although the contract aggregate amount will increase, the billing rates will remain at the same uniform rate for each contracted rehabilitation registry.

Therefore, RCRMC requests that the existing agreements with Career Staffing Unlimited, Medical Staffing Network, Inc., Preferred Healthcare Registry, Inc., Rehababilities, Inc., and RPT PRN be amended to increase the total aggregate amount for fiscal year 2009/2010.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Contracts will be funded 100% under the Hospital Enterprise Funds.
