SUBJECT: Loan of Results Cartridges to the City and County of San Francisco

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the loan of 1,120 Edge results cartridges containing 512MB compact flash cards to the City and County of San Francisco for use in the June 8, 2010 Statewide Primary election.

BACKGROUND: The City and County of San Francisco (San Francisco) has determined that their June 8, 2010 Statewide Primary ballot will be three times larger than any previous ballot for the county. San Francisco's 256MB results cartridges will not accommodate the size of the ballot. Results cartridges, also known as PCMIA cartridges, are obsolete technology and no longer readily available. The industry has moved to USB drives.

Riverside County has an inventory of 3,700 512MB results cartridges. We will use 1,000 in the conduct of the June Statewide Primary. San Francisco has submitted a formal request letter to the Registrar of Voters (attached) requesting the County to loan San Francisco 1,120 Edge results cartridges with 512MB compact flash cards for use in the June 8, 2010 Statewide Primary election

Board Policy H-3 prohibits the loan of election equipment without Board approval.
