## **BACKGROUND:**

On June 10, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved six support projects for the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility Expansion No. 3. The Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility Warehouse Project is necessary to accommodate the increase in the facility's inmate population due to the completion of the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility Expansion No. 3 project.

On July 14, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved an agreement with TR Design Services for design of the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility Warehouse. The bid documents are now complete and the Economic Development Agency (EDA) requests approval to solicit bids for the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility Warehouse.
