SUBJECT: Acceptance of funding and approval of the Amendment with Riverside Community College District (RCCD) to establish a Physician Assistant Mental Health Fellowship Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1) Authorize the Chairperson to accept, on behalf of the Board, \$99,808 funding from RCCD to support the Physician Assistant Mental Health Fellowship Program; and

2) Approve the amendment between Riverside County and RCCD to use Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) facilities for training with the Physician Assistant Mental Health Fellowship Program effective January 1, 2010; and

3) Authorize the Chairperson to execute four (4) copies of the Amendment; and

4) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) copy and return three (3) copies of the signed amendments to Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) administration for distribution.

BACKGROUND: The RCCD and RCRMC Family Practice Physicians have established an integrated physician assistant training program to ensure physician assistant students receive a wide variety of clinical experiences to assure physician assistant students are well trained. In an effort to continue to meet the

BACKGROUND (Continued):

needs of the RCCD Physician Assistant training program, RCCD and RCRMC have agreed to provide clinical training and experience in Psychiatry health care services to the graduate physician assistants enrolled in the RCCD mental health fellowship program.

Beginning July 1, 2010, this fellowship program will provide on-site education and training to a maximum of three (3) graduate physician assitants, per fellowship rotation, for the care of patients in clinical field of psychiatry. RCRMC will meet with RCCD to develop and operate the program incorporating the principles of the Medical Health Service Act.

This Amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

AMENDMENT TO THE COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER AND RIVERSIDE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

That certain Agreement between the Riverside County Regional Medical Center ("HOSPITAL"), on behalf of the County of Riverside ("COUNTY"), and Riverside Community College District ("RCCD") dated March 23, 1998 is hereby amended effective January 1, 2010, pursuant to the following:

- The language of Exhibit A is deleted in its entirety and replaced as Attachment I, attached hereto.
- 2. Delete Section 1 and replace with the following:
 - "1. The Cooperative Educational Physician Assistant Program will be reviewed and approved in writing by the Director of the Hospital or designee, on an annual basis, unless otherwise indicated in writing in the Program Addendum (Exhibit A). The Physician Assistant Program is described in Exhibit B. The Mental Health Fellowship Program is described in Exhibit C."
- 3 Delete Section 26 and replace with the following:
 - "26 Any notice sent pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing and sent to the following:

COUNTY and RCCD hereby agree that the Physician Assistant Fellowship Program as contemplated in the Cooperative Education Agreement shall include and otherwise comply with the following:

PROGRAM TITLE:

Mental Health Special Program

OBJECTIVES:

Provide graduate physician assistants enrolled in the mental health fellowship program an opportunity to gain advanced training and experience in psychiatry specialty incorporating the principles of the Mental Health Service Act.

CLINICAL AREAS:

Department of Mental Health;

HOSPITAL, Emergency Medical Treatment Services;

HOSPITAL, Inpatient Treatment Facility.

EFFECTIVE PROGRAM

DATES:

March 1, 2010 thru June 30, 2011

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

3 maximum per fellowship rotation

PROGRAM SCHEDULE:

Weekdays during Clinical hours. All other schedules arranged

with respective program chairman or department head.

Length of clinical rotation is six (6) months

- ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS: 1. The HOSPITAL shall instruct each student of its Infection Control Program, the Body Substance Isolation System (BSIS), in accordance with Hospital policy. A student may not engage in patient care activities until orientation in BSIS is completed.
 - 2. On-call rooms provided when students are on-call (clinical year).
 - 3. Medical direction for the program furnished by the Program Director at 20% released time. (Eight (8) hours per week).
 - 4. Clinical Curriculum will be approved by Graduate Medical Education Committee (GME).
 - 5. Program Director shall meet with RCCD, or its designee, as requested.
 - 6. Enrollees will be provided a monthly stipend of three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500) payable no later than the 5th working day of each month.

FUNDING PROVISIONS:

Maximum reimbursable amount for the Mental Health Fellowship Program is ninety-nine thousand, eight hundred eight dollars (\$99,808) as awarded to RCCD by the Song-Brown Health Care Workforce Training Act payable to COUNTY upon execution of this Agreement.

PROGRAM REPORTING:

Quarterly financial reports outlining expenditures will be provided to RCCD within forty-five (45) calendar days after the end of the quarter.
