RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board, as a result of a majority protest having been received, abandon all proceedings for the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 98 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated of the County of Riverside.

BACKGROUND: On March 16, 2010, a public hearing was held to receive all testimony regarding the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 98 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated ("L&LMD No. 89-1-C"). After closing the public hearing, the Board directed the Director of Transportation, or his/her designee, to tally the assessment ballots that had been received prior to the close of the hearing. The assessment ballots were to be tabulated on March 17, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in Conference Room D on the 8th Floor of the

County Administrative Center. The tabulation shows that votes representing 1 parcel out of a possible 1 were cast, and that 1 vote (or 100%) was cast against the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 98 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and the levy and enrollment of the special assessment. Pursuant to Section 22593 of the Streets and Highways Code, this represents a majority protest and the proceedings for the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 98 must be abandoned.

The project proponent has since reapplied for annexation into L&LMD No. 89-1-C for streetlight maintenance. A new election will be conducted pursuant to that application.
