- authorize the abatement costs to be added to the tax roll as a special assessment.

BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 520 (RCC Title 10), 348 (RCC Title 17), 457 (RCC Title 15), 541(RCC Chapter 8.120) and 725 (RCC Title 1.16) authorize for the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of

The City of Menifee was incorporated on October 1, 2008 and agreed to reimburse the County of Riverside for all code enforcement fees and costs incurred up to June 30, 2009.

A portion of funds received pursuant to the abatement lien and special assessment authorized herein may be repaid or credited to the City of Menifee, if applicable, due to prior reimbursement for the cost of code enforcement services pursuant to California Government Code §57384(b).
