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

## NORCO MDP LINE NA-3 AND NORTH NORCO CHANNEL LINE N-1 STAGE 2



Norco MDP Line NA-3 will be located along Pedley Ave between 6th Street and 5th Street. The line will extend approximately 1,400 feet south from 6th Street. The proposed alignment will run along the street travel way staying within the street right—of—way (60' R/W). The proposed facility will be a reinforced concrete pipe constructed underground. Pipe size will range from 24" to 42" RCP. This facility will connect to an existing 63" lateral that joins the existing Line NA, Stage 2 and runs westerly along 6th Street.

North Norco Channel Line N-1, Stage 2 will begin from an existing 39" mainline approximately 135 feet east of the intersection of Pedley Avenue and 7th Street. The proposed facility will consist of reinforced concrete pipe being placed underground and travel easterly along 7th street then south on California Avenue. The proposed alignment on 7th Street will remain within the street travel way. The proposed alignment running south along California Avenue will travel along the equestrian trail (westerly side of street), but will remain within the street right-of-way (60' R/W). The approximate length of Line N-1 is 2,200 feet. Pipe size will range from 24" to 30" RCP.



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
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
