BACKGROUND: Since 2001, the Riverside National Cemetery's annual Concert for Heroes is the only symphonic concert held in a National Cemetery. The Inland Empire/Riverside Philharmonic Orchestra, conducted by Patrick Flynn, will perform a program of patriotic and popular classics including the Light Caivary Overture and Tchaikovsky's March Slav and concludes with John Phillip Sousa's immortal Stars and Stripes Forever. A brief ceremony remembering and honoring Prisoners Of War and those still Missing in Action (POW/MIA) will be included.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$1,000 to support Concert for Heroes.
